The four-mile ITC Corridor Trail is a collaboration between ITC Holdings Corp. and the City of Novi.

Hours: Dawn to Dusk

- •No motorized vehicles permitted with the exception of power driven mobility devices related to disabilities.
- •Pets must be on a leash at all times and owners must clean up all solid waste.
- Alcohol is not permitted.
- •Helmet use is highly recommended.
- •There is no restroom access on the trail. Public restrooms are available seasonally at ITC Community Sports Park and Wildlife Woods Park.
- •Bikers must yield to walkers/joggers. Stay to the right and pass to the left. Announce you are passing.
- •Be mindful of neighbors do not litter, keep the volume reasonable and stay on the marked trail.
- •Vehicles are not required to stop at road crossings. Proceed only when clear.
- •The trail is not plowed or groomed in the winter.

HOW TO USE AN RRFB SIGN AT THE ROAD CROSSINGS

- 1. The light is normally dark.
- 2. Press button to activate flashing lights.
- 3. The lights will flash rapidly for about 30 seconds to alert motorists.
- 4. Only cross when the intersection is clear. Cars do not need to stop.
