What is Electronic Waste (E-Waste)?

E-Waste means electronic products nearing the end of their "useful life." Many of these products can be reused, refurbished, or recycled. Often, they contain recyclable components that have value if properly recycled. They also often have hazardous constituents such as lead, mercury and flame retardants that can pose an environmental or health threat if not properly handled.

Examples of Acceptable E-Waste Items:

- Desktop Computers
- Monitors
- Printers
- Keyboards
- Laptops
- Scanners
- Other Computer Peripherals
- DVD & VHS Players
- Radios
- Stereo Equipment
- Cellular Telephones
- Household Telephones
- Video Game Consoles
- Cameras and Camcorders
- Televisions
- MP3 Players
- Satellite Dishes

NOT ACCEPTED at E-Waste Events:

- × Household Appliances
- × Air Conditioners
- × Dehumidifiers

Facts and Figures about Electronic Waste:

- According to the EPA, in the U.S., we got rid of (dispose or recycle) 142,000 computers and over 416,000 mobile devices EVERY DAY!
- In 2012, in the U.S, we generated 3.4 million tons of e-waste. Of this amount, only 1 million tons or 29.2 % was recycled. The rest was landfilled or incinerated.
- According to the EPA, experts estimate that recycling 1 million cell phones can recover:
 - ♻️ 50 lbs. of gold; 550 lbs. of silver; 20 lbs. of palladium; more than 20,000 lbs. of copper
