

SUBJECT: K-9 REPLACEMENT – BUDGET AMMENDMENT REQUEST

DATE: APRIL 9, 2008

Due to recent deteriorating health issues with one of our police K-9's, it has become necessary for Officer Jeffrey Brown to retire his partner Yukon. Yukon has served our department and community with distinction for over seven years and we will miss his services greatly.

Given these circumstances, we recommend filling this void in our K-9 unit by reserving a space in the Police Patrol Dog Academy being held at the Oakland Police Academy in May 2008. If approved, a Novi police officer will be sent to this five week academy where he/she will become a fully trained Police Dog handler after over 200 hours of hands-on training. A unique part of this program is that the cost includes the purchase of an already partially trained German shepherd which will be imported from Holland. The cost of the dog and all training equipment is included in the overall price of the academy.

Total Costs	\$10,100
K-9 Officer uniforms	\$600
Cost of tuition for handler training	\$3,500
Cost of a partially trained K-9	\$6,000

By taking advantage of the Police Patrol Dog Academy, we will be able to deploy the handler and dog at the successful completion of the five week training and certification process. In previous years the training to get a fully certified handler and K-9 ready for Uniform Patrol duty has taken upwards of twelve months. Several Police Departments and Sheriff's Offices within the Detroit Metropolitan area have used this program to support their K-9 units and have found it to be successful and very economical. Police dog purchases and handler training is an allowable use of State Forfeiture Funds. If you have any questions, please let me know.

In response to your inquiry, the costs associated with putting together the Novi University program to date are approximately \$2,600. This includes approximately \$400 in supplies including binders and tabs. The remaining \$2,200 is for Novi University tee shirts which each attendee will receive and coffee mugs which will be give-a-ways during the various sessions. The goal is to gradually purchase additional give-a-ways as we get further into the year so that attendees will have a chance to leave the sessions with various Novi University memorabilia.

The City's Walk for Better Health Team Challenge which will begin on May 5th has a program cost of approximately \$2,800. This may be slightly higher or lower depending upon the number of participants who get involved. This cost includes \$35.00 gift cards to be given to each participant who finishes the program and who meets their individual goals as set forth at the beginning of the program.

Also, as discussed, the winning team, the team that has the greatest percentage of body fat lost, wins \$200.00, which is taxable, per team member. The teams will consist of 4 participants.
