SUBJECT: Approval of Change Order No. 1 for the Miller Creek Pond Dredging project to Hamlin Grading and Excavating in the amount of \$6,560.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The construction contract for this project was awarded at the January 24, 2011 City Council meeting. The project involves the dredging of a private in-line basin to remove silt that collected during the construction of the upstream Dunbarton Basin improvements completed in 2007. The contractor commenced work in accordance with the original schedule and was on schedule to complete the work by the first week of March, which is when frost laws are typically imposed. (To protect roads, frost laws dictate that trucks with axle loads above a particular weight are not allowed on certain road while the road bed is thawina). However, frost laws were imposed in Wayne County on February 21 (see attached Wayne County news release) impacting the route planned by the contractor to transport the dredged soil to the landfill as required by the contract and the Michigan Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ) permit. Therefore, the contractor is requesting \$6,560 to offset the increased time and mileage associated with a revised route to the landfill caused by the early effect of frost laws (see attached change order request from Hamlin). The contractor's original planned route to the landfill, located near Napier Road and Five Mile Road, included Eight Mile Road and Napier Road; however the frost laws caused him to change his route to use all-weather roads such as I-275, M-14, Beck Road and Five Mile Road.

Another aspect of the claim is that the early thaw reduced the contractor's productivity on the site. The project was proposed in February anticipating that the work would be completed with frozen ground. The rising temperatures made the ground less stable for the equipment and required extra care to limit disruption of the site. The contractor also claims that the longer round trip to the landfill caused additional time on site that was not anticipated in the bid.

It is typical for frost laws to be imposed in early March (usually the first or second week). Because the work was to be completed by February 28 under the MDEQ permit conditions, it was not anticipated in the bid documents that frost laws would be a factor in the bid. Staff has reviewed the change order request and recommends award of the change order. The revised contract price including this change order is \$22,810, which is \$1,990 less than the second lowest bid.

The work is substantially complete with restoration yet to be completed this spring.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

This project involves the dredging of a private in-line basin to remove silt that collected during the construction of the upstream Dunbarton Basin improvements completed in 2007. Despite having adequate erosion and sedimentation controls in place, silt and sediment migrated off-site during the 2-year construction project and settled in a downstream pond, as verified by Engineering staff. The pond is located on private property at 44000 Nine Mile Road and is approximately 120' x 40' in size. The attached vicinity map and site plan map is provided for reference. Although approved in the City's FY09/10 CIP, the project is just now ready to be done due to a lengthy Michigan Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ) permitting process.

In close coordination with the property owner, the site investigation, engineering, and permit acquisition from the MDEQ for the project was completed using in-house staff. Additionally, the contract administration and construction inspection for this project will be completed by DPS Engineering Division staff (for a total savings of approximately \$7,300 on this project for services typically provided by consultants).

Twelve bids were received and opened on January 13, 2011 following a public bid solicitation period. The lowest bidder is Hamlin Grading and Excavating. Hamlin's bid is recommended as being in the best interest of the City as it is responsive (i.e., Hamlin has complied with all requirements of the bidding instructions) and it is the lowest price. Staff reviewed all bids, and checked the list of references provided by Hamlin. A summary of the twelve bids is listed in the table on the following page.

The project was included in the FY2009-10 capital improvement program in the budgeted amount of \$75,000, of which \$7,150 was spent for the geotechnical work and permit fees, and \$16,250 is now being recommended for award to Hamlin for construction for a total contract award in the amount of \$23,400.

Construction is scheduled to begin in February 2011 and be complete by summer 2011.




Miller Creek In-Line Pond Dredging Site Plan





Miller Creek In-Line Pond Dredging Vicinity Map 44000 Nine Mile Road, Novi, MI








