

PROCLAMATION
Drinking Water Week
May 1-7, 2011

WHEREAS, water fulfills a basic and essential need for the health, comfort and well-being of all things that depend on it to live; and

WHEREAS, only tap water delivers public health protection, fire protection, support for our economy, and the quality of life we enjoy; and

WHEREAS, any measure of a successful society – low mortality rates, economic growth and diversity, productivity, and public safety – are in some way related to access to safe water; and

WHEREAS, we are all stewards of the water infrastructure upon which future generations depend; and

WHEREAS, each citizen of our community is called upon to help protect our source waters from pollution, to practice water conservation, and to get involved in local water issues.

NOW, therefore, I, David B. Landry, Mayor of the City of Novi, on behalf of the Novi City Council, do hereby proclaim the week of May 1 through 7, 2011 Drinking Water Week in the City of Novi.
