SUBJECT: Approval to purchase a water and sewer utility service truck from QT Equipment, Inc., the lowest responsive bidder, in the amount of \$154,910.94.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The Capital Improvements Program shows a replacement water and sewer utility service truck for an estimated amount of \$155,000. The existing utility service truck is Truck No. 708 - a 1999 Ford F-350 that is in poor condition and severely undersized (see attached photographs). Formal budgets are typically adopted by resolution for utility funds; this utility truck was not separately listed in the operating budget because of an accounting oversight, but funds are available for its procurement.

The utility truck must have the ability to carry a generator, air compressor and welder to be able to respond to routine and emergency water and sewer issues. To compensate for the lack of storage space, two trucks currently have to respond to water main breaks, sewage backups and lift station failures. In addition, the crane on Truck No. 708 is small and cannot remove the pumps at larger lift stations because when the boom is extended, it does not have sufficient load capacity. The replacement utility service truck will address all of these shortcomings and inefficiencies.

Five bids were received on November 20, 21012 following a competitively solicited bidding period. QT Equipment, Inc. of Akron, OH provided the lowest responsive bid price for the truck. (The lowest bid was submitted by Cannon Engineering and Equipment, Inc.; however, Cannon's bid price of \$150,595 did not meet the lifting capacity requirements for the crane, the horsepower requirements for the truck's motor, and the gear ratio requirements for the truck's rear differential.) Because it typically takes 3-4 months to fully outfit a specialty truck of this type, QT Equipment is slated to make delivery of the new service truck by April 2013. The old truck will be sold for surplus upon delivery of the new one.

RECOMMENDED ACTION: Approval to purchase a water and sewer utility service truck from QT Equipment, Inc., the lowest responsive bidder, in the amount of \$154,910.94.






The service truck capacities should reflect the capacities required in the field operations. The current service truck is based on an F350 chassis, and lacks the towing capacity for the Water and Sewer Division's excavating equipment. The new service truck will have increased capacities to efficiently operate in the field.













The point of egress on a service truck is the rear bumper and tailgate assembly. The current service truck bumper is suffering from corrosion and has had the external stabilizers serviced multiple times due to this. The new service truck will have a formed step platform for egress as well as an incorporated storage compartment for long tools.



The cabinet lighting of a service truck is important for night-time operations. Current lighting in the cabinets has been inadequate at best. The new truck will have factory lighting in all of the cabinets as well as perimeter lighting.

A service truck crane is used daily in the Water & Sewer operations. The current crane capacity at a 0 degree angle is 675 pounds. The new service truck will have a lifting capacity of 5000 pounds and the ability to lift all of our sanitary lift station pumps.

The current service truck body is rusting out at the bottom of the cabinets. The outside appearance does not accurately indicate the overall level of corrosion this truck has.
