The City of Novi will be celebrating the grand re-opening of Ella Mae Power Park, located behind the Novi Civic Center on **Thursday**, **June 11**, **2009 at 6:15PM**. The barbeque is open to the public and is a FREE community event celebrating the park enhancements, no RSVP is needed. Hotdogs, children's entertainment, including balloon animals, magic and softball will be part of the fun.

Over the last two years, \$1.2 million has been invested in the park resulting in new infield surfacing, field lighting, landscaping, and concession and restroom facilities. The Park is home to Novi Parks' adult softball programs and numerous tournaments. This summer, because of the improvements at the park, the City of Novi will host the largest Michigan ASA girls fast pitch tournament of the 2009 season. The 2009 Michigan ASA Girls Fast Pitch State Finals will be held in Novi the weekend of June 25 – 28, 2009. Over 70 teams (totaling at least 1,000 players and their families) will be visiting Novi to compete at the highest level of fast pitch softball for girls ages 9 – 18.
