ELECTION COMMISSION MEETING
March 1, 2022

The meeting was called to order at 3:00 p.m. with City Clerk Hanson presiding.

A quorum being present, the Commission was declared in session.

PURPOSE OF MEETING:

1. Approval of minutes from September 29, 2021 meeting.

To approve the minutes from September 29, 2021.

2. Approval of a resolution to revise the voting precinct boundaries of Precincts 12 and 13 due to Statewide Redistricting.

City Clerk Hanson explained that Precincts 12 and 13 would benefit from moving the boundary line to include Ardmore Court in Precinct 12. It would follow the newly created State Senate District boundary line and prevent two ballot styles. She also explained that Precinct 14 would have two ballot styles because the Congressional District boundary line went through it instead of along the existing precinct boundary. It will be in the best interest of the voters in Precinct 14 to not move the precinct boundary.

City Clerk Hanson read a comment from Commissioner Copes into the record:
"I wish to be read into the minutes for the purpose of stating my support of the resolution to revise the voting precinct boundaries of Precincts 12 and 13 due to the Statewide Redistricting. While I am not in full agreement with either the Michigan Independent Redistricting Commission's outcome nor the Oakland County Board of Commissioner's redistricting, as a member of the Election Commission I believe that we have no alternative than to approve the resolution to revise the affected precinct boundaries."

Moved by Superfisky, seconded by Hanson; MOTION CARRIED

To approve a resolution to revise the voting precinct boundaries of Precincts 12 and 13 due to Statewide Redistricting.
