## BACKGROUND:

Included in the 2022-23 Budget Year was the purchase of a police drone. The RFP bid (Request for Proposal) was sent out over BidNet/MITN, and the results of the bid were received on June 28, 2022.

The bid was prepared with the two packages in mind, one being the Matrice 300, and one being the Matrice 30T. The Matrice 30T is a newer version of the DJI public safety drone that is designed to work together as a pair, with interoperability of controllers, handoff capabilities, and enhanced weather capabilities.

It is the Matrice $30 T$ that is recommended for purchase.

## RECOMMENDATION:

Three companies bid on the packages, with one bidder, Noar Technologies, being the lowest bidder. In addition, Noar Technologies is a local, metro-Detroit vendor, located in Clawson, Michigan, and has been the vendor to the Oakland County Sheriff's Office for their drone program, and they have had good success with using them.

They confirmed that they accept the normal purchase order process for ordering and payment, and all items they have in stock, except for the backpacks, which will be ordered with expedited delivery, upon award.

## SUBMISSION OF BID

Bids must be signed by an Authorized Representative of the submitting company on the enclosed form when one is provided. Bids must show unit and total prices when requested. In case of mistakes in price extension, unit pricing shall govern. ANY CHANGES MADE ON THE BID FORM MUST BE INITIALED OR YOUR BID MAY BE CONSIDERED NON-RESPONSIVE.

A bid may be withdrawn by giving written notice to the Purchasing Manager before the stated due date/closing time. After the stated closing time, the bid may not be withdrawn or canceled for a period of One Hundred and Twenty (90) days from closing time.

Bidders are expected to examine all specifications and instructions. Failure to do so will be at the bidder's risk.

Failure to include in the bid all information requested may be cause for rejection of the bid.

No bid will be accepted from, or contract awarded to any person, firm, or corporation that is in arrears or is in default to the City of Novi upon any debt or contract, or that is in default as surety or otherwise, or failed to perform faithfully any previous contract with the City.

## INELIGIBILITY OF IRAN LINKED BUSINESS

Under 2012 PA 517, an Iran Linked Business, as defined therein, is not eligible to contract with the City and shall not submit a bid.

## CONSIDERATION OF BIDS

In cases where items are requested by a manufacturer's name, trade name, catalog number or reference, it is understood that the bidder/proposer intends to furnish the item so identified or an item of "equal" quality and value as determined by the City of Novi.

Reference to any of the above is intended to be descriptive, but not restrictive, and only indicates articles that will be satisfactory. Bids of "equal" quality and value will be considered, provided that the bidder states in his/her bid what he/she proposed to
furnish, including literature, or other descriptive matter which will clearly indicate the character of the item covered by such bid.

The Purchasing Manager hereby reserves the right to approve as an "equal", any item proposed which contains minor or major variations from specification requirements, but which may comply substantially therewith.

## RESPONSIVE BIDS

All pages and the information requested herein shall be furnished completely in compliance with instructions. The manner and format of submission is essential to permit prompt evaluation of all bids on a fair and uniform basis. Unit prices shall be submitted if space is provided on bid form. In cases of mistakes in extension, the unit price shall govern. Accordingly, the City reserves the right to declare as non-responsive, and reject an incomplete bid if material information requested is not furnished, or where indirect or incomplete answers or information is not provided. Any exceptions to the specifications must be noted on the bid form.

## EXCEPTIONS

The City will not accept changes or exceptions to the bid documents/specifications unless Contractor indicates the change or exception in the "Exceptions" section of the bid form. If Contractor neglects to make the notation on the bid form but writes it somewhere else within the bid documents and is awarded the contract, the change or exception will not be included as part of the contract. The original terms, conditions and specifications of the bid documents will be applicable during the term of the contract.

## CONTRACT AWARD

## VENDOR DISQUALIFICATION

The City may terminate and/or cancel this contract (or any part thereof) at any time during the term, any renewal, or any extension of this contract, upon thirty days (30) days written notice to the Contractor, for any reason, including convenience without incurring obligation or penalty of any kind. The effective date for termination or cancellation shall be clearly stated in the written notice.

## TRANSFER OF CONTRACT/SUBCONTRACTING

The successful bidder will be prohibited from assigning, transferring, converting or otherwise disposing of the contract agreement to any other person, company or corporation without the expressed written consent of the City of Novi. Any subcontractor, so approved, shall be bound by the terms and conditions of the contract. ## INDEPENDENT PRICE DETERMINATION

By submission of a bid, the offeror certifies, and in case of a joint bid, each party hereto certifies as to its own organization, that in connection with the bid:
(a) The prices in the bid have been arrived at independently without consultation, communication, or agreement, for the purpose of restricting competition, as to any matter relating to such prices with any other offeror or with any other Competitor; and
(b) No attempt has been made or will be made by the offeror to induce any other person or firm to submit or not submit a bid for the purpose of restricting competition.

Each person signing the bid certifies that:
(c) He is the person in the offeror's organization responsible within that organization for the decision as to prices being offered in the bid and that he has not participated and will not participate in any action contrary to (a) and (b) above; or

b. Commercial General Liability Insurance - The Contractor shall procure and maintain during the life of this contract, Commercial General Liability Insurance, Personal Injury, Bodily Injury and Property Damage on an "Occurrence Basis" with limits of liability not less than $\$ 1,000,000$ (One Million Dollars) per occurrence combined single limit.
c. Automobile Liability insurance covering all owned, hired and non-owned vehicles with Personal Protection insurance to comply with the provisions of the Michigan No Fault Insurance Law including Residual Liability insurance with minimum bodily injury limits of $\mathbf{\$ 1 , 0 0 0 , 0 0 0}$ (One Million Dollars) each person and $\$ 1,000,000$ (One Million Dollars) each occurrence and minimum property damage limits of $\$ 1,000,000$ (One Million Dollars) each occurrence.
2. All policies shall name the Contractor as the insured and shall be accompanied by a commitment from the insurer that such policies shall not be canceled or reduced without at least thirty (30) days prior notice date to the City; alternately, contractor may agree to provide notice of such cancellation or reduction.
3. The City of Novi shall be named as Additional Insured for General Liability and Auto Liability. Certificates of Insurance evidencing such coverage shall be submitted to City of Novi, Purchasing Department, 45175 Ten Mile Road, Novi, Michigan 483753024 prior to commencement of performance under this Contract and at least fifteen (15) days prior to the expiration dates of expiring policies. A current certificate of insurance must be on file with the City for the duration of the contract. Said coverage shall be PRIMARY COVERAGE rather than any policies and insurance self-insurance retention owned or maintained by the City. Policies shall be issued by insurers who endorse the policies to reflect that, in the event of payment of any loss or damages, subrogation rights under those contract documents will be waived by the insurer with respect to claims against the City
4. The Contractor shall be responsible for payment of all deductibles contained in any insurance required hereunder.
5.
