BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The U.S. Department of Homeland Security (DHS) and the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) has posted the FY2014 Fire Prevention and Safety (FP&S) Grants as part of the Assistance to Firefighters Grants (AFG). The FP&S Grants support projects that enhance the safety of the public and firefighters from fire and related hazards. The primary goal is to reduce injury and prevent death among high-risk populations. There is just over \$34 million dollars in available grant funding. The performance period is 12 months from the date of an award. The application deadline is April 17, 2015. The City of Novi would have to match 5% of the grant request if awarded.

The Novi Fire Department asks for approval to apply for a project under the Fire Prevention and Safety Activity; activities designed to reach high-risk target groups and mitigate the incidence of death and injuries caused by fire and fire-related hazards. The department seeks approval to purchase battery powered smoke alarms. The target groups are older adults (65 and older) and mobile homes that currently lack working smoke alarms.

The Novi Fire Department in the past has provided smoke alarms through grants and donations; however, the funding has not been sustainable. The Novi Fire Department is working with Farmington Hills, Rochester Hills, Northville Township, Livonia and West Bloomfield Fire Departments to submit a regional grant project. The Novi Fire Department plans to request 400 smoke alarms with ten year lithium batteries and 20 Smoke alarms for the hearing impaired. Total project cost is \$12,437. City of Novi 5% match is \$622.

The performance period is 12 months from the date of an award. The application deadline is April 17, 2015. The City of Novi would have to match 5% of the grant request if awarded.

The Novi Fire Department asks for approval to apply for a project under the Fire Prevention and Safety Activity; activities designed to reach high-risk farget groups and mitigate the incidence of death and injuries caused by fire and fire-related hazards. The department seeks approval to purchase battery powered smoke alarms. The target groups are older adults (65 and older) and mobile homes that currently lack working smoke alarms. Over the past ten years the department has experienced three deaths in mobile homes, one death was in a high-rise condominium and one death in a twostory residential. Four out of five deaths were considered older adults. The City of Novi has 1,595 mobile home pads. The 2010 U.S. Census shows Novi has 6,248 older adults 65 and over and the Southeast Michigan Council of Governments (SEMCOG) projects by 2040 this will increase by 134%. The Novi Fire Department in the past has provided smoke alarms through grants and donations; however, the funding has not been sustainable. The Novi Fire Department is working with Farmington Hills, Rochester Hills, Northville Township, Livonia and West Bloomfield Fire Departments to submit a regional grant project. The Novi Fire Department plans to request 400 smoke alarms with ten year lithium batteries and 20 Smoke alarms for the hearing impaired.

10 ADA Horn Strobes @ \$98.77 each= \$987.70

10 ADA Horn Strobes with bed alert devices @ \$165.00 each = \$1650.00

Total Project= \$12,437.00

City of Novi 5% match = \$622.00
