SUBJECT: Approval of Resolution authorizing participation in the Road Commission for Oakland County's 2015 Tri-Party Program for Road Improvements dedicating Novi's 2015 allotment of \$161,038 to the Eastbound Grand River at Beck Dual Left Turn Lane Project.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The City of Novi has chosen to participate in the Road Commission for Oakland County's (RCOC) annual Tri-Party Program for Road Improvements for more than 25 years. Costs for project identified for participation are equally shared between three entities: the Oakland County Board of Commissioners, RCOC and the local unit of government.

In recent years, Novi has used the Tri-Party program to help fund various intersection signalization projects (12 Mile/Cabot), as well as major road improvement projects (Novi Road Link project from Ten Mile Road to Grand River Avenue, Grand River Avenue Rehabilitation from Novi Road to Haggerty Road, and Eight Mile Road between Beck and Napier). Based on fund distribution formulas, Novi's 2015 allocation totals \$161,038, with \$53,679 identified as Novi's cost share (see attached letter from RCOC). The allocation represents a 1.2% increase in the 2014 allocation of \$159,089.

Staff recommends that the 2015 allotment be allocated to Novi's share of the Eastbound Grand River at Beck Road Dual Left Turn Lane project that is proposed for construction this summer. The construction of a dual left turn at this intersection was identified as a crash mitigation improvement in the 2012 report that evaluated the high crash intersections in the City of Novi (excerpt attached), and was also recommended as an operational improvement in the 2011 I-96 Area Transportation Improvement Plan report.

This project received safety grant funding for 80% of the construction cost, which is currently estimated to be \$637,000. The total project cost, including construction and engineering is approximately \$713,000, of which \$452,000 is covered by the grant. The Tri-Party Program funding would reduce the contribution by the City of Novi from \$261,000 to \$153,641, which would be funded by the Municipal Street Fund.

The dual left turn lane project would be in addition to the right turn lane extension project for westbound Grand River at Beck Road to be constructed this year, which is also partially funded with a Federal grant. A map of the area is attached for reference.

ROAD COMMISSION FOR OAKLAND COUNTY TRI-PARTY PROGRAM

Your participation is requested in the FY 2015 Tri-Party Program. The fiscal year governing this program is October 1, 2014 through September 30, 2015. The Oakland County Board of Commissioners has approved a Tri-Party budget of \$1.0 million to create a \$3.0 million program for FY 2015. A total of \$1.5 million will be designated for townships and a total of \$1.5 million will be designated for cities and villages.

The distribution formula and method of calculation of Tri-Party allocations have remained the same in an attempt to most equitable distribute the Tri-Party dollars. For cities and villages, it includes RCOC road miles and three-year average annual accidents. For townships, the most recent census population figures are combined with RCOC road miles and three-year annual accidents. The figures for these three factors (population, miles and accidents) are calculated as the individual community's percentage of the total of each factor in each type of community. For example, county road accidents in a city or village are divided by the total of all county road accidents in all cities and villages.

Separate formulas are used because population in the city/village equation would skew the results toward more densely populated cities with fewer RCOC road miles. In townships, on the other hand, population has been used as a determining factor to prevent the distribution from being skewed toward townships with high road miles and small populations.

Population data is changed only after a decennial census or if the Census Bureau issues revised numbers. The data includes the most recent counts from the 2010 Census.

The most recent traffic accident data available from the Traffic Improvement Association of Oakland County is from 2011 to 2013.

The report lists the projects that have been completed with their associated costs and shows the allocations that have been reserved for future Tri-Party projects.

WHEREAS; the City of Novi supports and strongly encourages the continuation of an annual Tri-Party Program with participation by the local unit of government, the Road Commission for Oakland County and the County Board of Commissioners; and

WHEREAS; \$161,038 has been allocated for Novi with the total 2015 contribution from the City of Novi totaling \$53,679; and,

WHEREAS; the construction of a dual left turn at this intersection was identified as a crash mitigation improvement in the 2012 report that evaluated the high crash intersections in the City of Novi, and was also recommended as an operational improvement in the 2011 I-96 Area Transportation Improvement Plan report; and,

WHEREAS; this project was selected for safety grant funding for 80% of the construction cost, is scheduled for construction in 2015; and,

WHEREAS; the Tri-Party Program funding would help leverage the Federal grant funds for the project and reduce the contribution by the City of Novi.


We have received the attached letter from the Road Commission for Oakland County (RCOC) regarding the 2015 Tri-Party Program. As you will recall the Tri-Party Program provides an annual funding source for roads in which RCOC, Oakland County, and the community each provide one-third of the funds for a project. It provides the communities with a way to leverage local funds to complete projects on roads under RCOC jurisdiction. Since 1980, this has resulted in a \$5.8 million investment in the City of Novi and has helped Novi fund major improvements such as the Novi Road Link (Ten Mile Road to Main Street) project, Grand River Rehabilitation (Novi Road to Haggerty Road) and the Eight Mile Road Rehabilitation (Beck to Napier).

As stated in the attached letter from RCOC, the City of Novi's allotment for the 2015 Tri-Party Program is \$161,038, of which \$53,679 is Novi's share and the \$107,359 balance is split equally between Oakland County and RCOC.

Staff recommends that the 2015 allotment be allocated to Novi's share of the Eastbound Grand River at Beck Road Dual Left Turn Lane project that is proposed for construction this summer. The project received safety grant funding for 80% of the construction cost, which is currently estimated to be \$637,000. The remaining project cost, including construction and engineering is approximately \$713,000, of which \$452,000 is covered by the grant. The Tri-Party Program funding would reduce the contribution by the City of Novi from \$261,000 to \$153,641, which would be funded by the Municipal Street Fund.

Looking ahead at the future Tri-Party Program allocations, staff recommends that the 2016 and 2017 Tri-Party Program allocations be used for the City's share of the Napier Road Paving and Ten Mile Intersection project that is currently scheduled for construction to start in 2017.

A resolution in this regard will be prepared for City Council consideration at a future meeting.
