BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Improvements to the Civic Center Main Parking Lot (south of the Civic Center) and Novi Way, along with the Police Department's east entrance drive were recommended by the Parking Lot Inventory and Maintenance Plan completed in January 2014. The work in the main parking lot and Novi Way will include crack repair and patching followed by a hotmixed-asphalt overlay of the entire parking lot and Novi Way. The pavement cross-section for Novi Way also includes a geotextile fabric separator beneath the asphalt overlay to decrease reflective cracking associated with higher traffic on the access road. Improvements to the Police Department's east Entrance will include repairs followed by a hot-mixed-asphalt overlay of the entire entrance. The Power Park Pathway Rehabilitation component includes full depth reconstruction and rehabilitation of selected pathway segments in Power Park with pathway widening and drainage upgrades to improve maintenance access for City staff. These projects have been combined because of their close proximity to each other to receive a lower bid based on economies of scale.

The construction phase engineering fees are determined using two components: 1) the contract administration fee, which is determined using the fee percentage in Exhibit B of the Agreement For Professional Engineering Services for Public Projects, and 2) the construction inspection fee determined using a cost per inspection (crew) day from Exhibit B of the consultant's agreement that is then multiplied by the number of days of

inspection specified by the contractor. The construction phase fees for this project include a contract administration fee of \$26,742 (4.0% of the \$668,539 construction bid) and an inspection fee of \$17,920 (\$640 per crew day, multiplied by the 40 days provided in the contractor's bid) for a total fee of \$44,662.

The construction contract award is proposed for consideration elsewhere on this agenda.

It is anticipated that the construction of the project will begin this summer (after the major softball tournament to be held at Power Park in late July) and be completed this fall.

<u>FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE</u> <u>SUPPLEMENTAL PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES AGREEMENT</u>

NOVI WAY & CIVIC CENTER PARKING LOT REHABILITATION, <u>POLICE DEPARTMENT DRIVEWAY REHABILITATION,</u> <u>POWER PARK PATHWAYS REHABILITATION</u>

First Amended Agreement between the City of Novi, 45175 W. Ten Mile Road, Novi, MI 48375-3024, hereafter, "City," and URS Corporation – Great Lakes., whose address is 27777 Franklin Road, Suite 2000, Southfield, MI 48034, hereafter, "Consultant." relating to modifications of the fee basis for engineering services. The following sections of the Supplemental Professional Engineering Services Agreement, as made and entered into on January 25, 2016 shall be amended as follows:

<u>Section 2. Payment for Professional Engineering Services.</u> The following Paragraphs shall be amended as follows:

- 1. <u>Basic Fee.</u>
 - a. Delete 1.a. in its entirety and replace with the following language: The Consultant shall complete the design phase services as described herein for a lump sum fee of \$26,742, which is 4.00% of the estimated construction cost (\$668,539) as indicated on the design and construction engineering fee curve provided in Exhibit B of the Agreement for Professional Engineering Services for Public Projects.
 - b. Unchanged

Except as specifically set forth in this First Amendment, the Supplemental Professional Engineering Services Agreement remains in full force and effect.






