SUBJECT: Approval to award a construction contract for the Country Place Force Main Replacement project to Giannetti Building Development LLC., the low bidder, in the amount of \$294,049, subject to final review and approval of form of agreement by City Manager's office and the City Attorney.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

This project involves improvements to the Country Place Pump Station and force main to increase the pump station capacity and redundancy at the station. A recent capacity study indicated that the design peak flow would exceed the capacity of the station. In addition to capacity upgrades, the station is in need of redundancy upgrades as the station's force main is a 40 year old asbestos cement (AC) pipe, which makes it prone to failure. The remote location of this pump station does not allow for the option to manually pump to a downstream location in the event of an emergency. If the existing force main were to fail, the station's flows would very quickly begin to back up into the residential basements in the area, resulting in a major disaster. For this reason, a new parallel force main (~2000 feet in length) is being proposed, while leaving the existing AC force main in place as a redundant backup should the new force main ever be damaged or need repair.

A total of eight bids were received and opened on November 16, 2016 following a public bid solicitation period. The lowest bidder is Giannetti Building Development. Giannetti's bid is recommended as being in the best interest of the City as it is responsive (i.e., Giannetti has complied with all requirements of the bidding instructions) and it is the lowest price. (SDA's award recommendation letter including the bid tabulation dated November 21, 2016 is attached). A summary of the eight bids is as follows:



On November 16, 2016 at 2:00 p.m., construction bids were opened and publicly read at the City of Novi Civic Center for the Country Place Force Main Replacement project. The project includes directionally drilling a replacement force main and replacing pumps and appurtenances at the existing pump station located at Country Place Condominiums.

The City Clerk's office received eight (8) sealed bids for this project, with each bidder considered to be responsive having submitted a bid compliant with all requirements. The apparent low bidder, Giannetti Building Development, submitted a total bid of \$313,249.00. Following the bid opening, Spalding DeDecker reviewed all of the bids received, verified the calculations, and prepared the bid tabulation for the project (attached).

Based on a review of experience and references provided, Spalding DeDecker finds that Giannetti Building Development is qualified to perform the required construction.

It is our recommendation that the project be awarded to the low bidder, Giannetti Building Development for the Country Place Force Main Replacement project in the amount of \$294,049.00, which is the total bid of \$313,249.00 minus \$19,200.00 for crew days bid.

Upon award by the City Council, our office will coordinate the completion of the Contract Agreement, Bonds, and Insurance information with Giannetti Building Development.






