SUBJECT: Approval to award a construction contract for the 2014 Neighborhood Road Program—Contract 1 (Asphalt) to Pavex Corporation, the low bidder, in the amount of \$1,166,945, subject to final review and approval of form of agreement by the City Manager's office and City Attorney.

#### BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Each year, the City of Novi selects residential streets for reconstruction, repaving, repair, and/or rehabilitation based on PASER ratings, staff's field observations and resident concerns. The 2014 program will consist of two separate contracts: one for concrete streets and one for asphalt streets. This year's program will implement the City's Asset Management approach for pavements that was established in 2009. This project includes multiple treatment methods, which were determined during the design process based on our asset management approach of focusing on preventative maintenance where appropriate and extending the life of the City's roads in the most cost-effective manner.

The asset management program stresses the importance of using preventative maintenance to preserve good quality roads using low-cost rehabilitation techniques, rather than allowing the roads to deteriorate to a point that requires reconstruction involving much more effort at a higher cost. Roads that have deteriorated significantly will be addressed with rehabilitation methods such as overlays, panel replacements, and joint repairs to allow more efficient application of available road funds to maximize the number of neighborhood streets included in each year of the annual program.

This year's program involves the streets listed below and as shown on the attached map:

The interlayer and geogrid are geosynthetic paving materials designed to extend the service life of the pavement. The interlayer is constructed of a fiberglass mesh embedded into high performance polyester mats and is placed between asphalt lifts to provide additional strength and resist reflective cracking, while also preventing moisture infiltration into the pavement structure. The geogrid is placed within the aggregate base layer to reduce subgrade stresses by spreading point loads over a larger area (i.e., the "snowshoe effect").

Six (6) bids were received and opened on June 6, 2014 following a public bid solicitation period. The lowest bidder is Pavex Corporation. Pavex's bid is recommended as being in the best interest of the City as it is responsive (i.e. Pavex has complied with all requirements of the bidding instructions) and it is the lowest price. (SDA's award recommendation letter including the bid tabulation dated June 5, 2014 is attached.) Pavex completed the work at Village Wood Lake Park in 2012. A summary of the six bids is as follows:


Construction of the project will begin this summer and be substantially complete this construction season.

A second construction contract for concrete neighborhood roads is presented elsewhere on this agenda for a total construction value of approximately \$1,828,804 this season. There is \$400,000 remaining in the budget for neighborhood roads, which will result in a third construction contract to be bid out in spring 2015.

**RECOMMENDED ACTION:** Approval to award a construction contract for the 2014 Neighborhood Road Program--Contract 1 (Asphalt) to Pavex Corporation, the low bidder, in the amount of \$1,166,945, subject to final review and approval of form of agreement by the City Manager's office and City Attorney.

Dear Mr. Croy:

On June 4, 2014, at 2:00 p.m. construction bids were opened and publicly read at the City of Novi Civic Center for the 2014 Neighborhood Roads Program - Asphalt. The project includes the Asphalt reconstruction of Wedgewood Drive, the asphalt overlay throughout Haverhill Farms Subdivision, and the asphalt reconstruction of Malott Drive and portions of Lebost Drive, including sidewalk improvements throughout the project scope.

The City Clerk's office received six (6) sealed bids for this project, with each bidder considered to be responsive having submitted a bid compliant with all requirements. The apparent low bidder, Pavex Corporation, submitted a total bid of \$1,198,944.70. Following the bid opening, Spalding DeDecker Associates (SDA) reviewed all of the bids received, verified the calculations, and prepared the bid tabulation for the project (attached).

Based on a review of experience and references provided by Pavex Corporation, SDA finds that Pavex Corporation is qualified to perform the required construction.

It is our recommendation that the project be awarded to the low bidder, Pavex Corporation, for the 2014 Neighborhood Roads Program - Asphalt in the amount of \$1,166,944.70, which is the total bid of \$1,198,944.70 minus \$32,000.00 for crew days bid.

Upon award by the City Council, our office will coordinate the completion of the Contract Agreement, Bonds and Insurance information with Pavex Corporation, and issue the Notice to Proceed upon execution of the contract documents.



The undersigned agrees that in case it shall fail to fulfill its obligations under the foregoing Bid, and/or shall fail to furnish bonds, as specified, the OWNER may, at its option determine that the undersigned has abandoned its rights and interests in such Contract and that its Bid security accompanying its Bid; has been forfeited to the said OWNER, but otherwise the Bid security shall be returned to the undersigned upon the execution of the Contract and the acceptance of the bonds.




