# Community Beautification Update

This month the Novi Parks, Recreation and Cultural Services Department will be installing the Novi Public Library's Read Box at Brookfarm Park (next to Sub 3). Since the Willowbrook Community Association (WCA) does not maintain property in Sub 3, we are thrilled to partner with the city on this project. Thank you to everyone who donated to our Read Box Book Drive! We surpassed our goal of 300 books and donated 350 as of 3/20 books to the library's Read Box Collection. The Novi Public Library (NPL) will use these and other books in their collection to rotate reading material weekly from May through October. A huge thank you to WCA resident Chris Kallas for donating her time and talent to decorating the Read Box. We hope you enjoy her artwork and a good book when you visit the Brookfarm Park. And remember, the Malott/E Le Bost island still has the WCA Little Library, along with benches and gardens for your enjoyment. The Willowbrook Community Association is a great place to be!

Here is how each of the book resources function for our subdivision:



Owned By	Willowbrook Community Association	Novi Public Library. (They own and operate four Read Boxes in Novi.)
Books	All Ages	All Ages
Months of Operation	All Year	May - October
Operation	In General: give a book, take a book (but can donate and take as desired)	Take a book and then return that book (no specific time limit). The NPL provide a weekly rotation of the books using their Read Box Collection.
Donating More Books	Any Time: drop off at the Little Library	Book drives - ONLY way to directly donate. NPL takes daily general donations (and some go to the Read Box).

Not only is the joy of books upon us, but the beauty of flowers and hopefully pollinators too! This will be our second spring with the WCA native flower gardens in Sub 1 and Sub 2. In the beginning, expect to find primarily green sedges and grasses. They are shorter and grow earlier, serving as a groundcover against weeds until the larger flowers have time to grow during the season. A variety of colors and blooms will follow soon afterwards and continue into the fall. If you would like to learn more about how our efforts are helping the ecosystem and/or about the specific plants used in the gardens, the educational sign at the Malott/E Le Bost island is an attractive resource.

Our gardens are built to be low-maintenance, but they do require some care (especially in the first few years of establishment). We welcome everyone to attend the WCA Spring Beautification Volunteer Event on Saturday, June 10<sup>th</sup>. It is a great way to give back to the community, meet other neighbors, share gardening tips, and enjoy some delicious treats!
