SUBJECT: Consideration of approval to award the construction contract to M-K Construction Co., Inc., the sole bidder, for the Middle Rouge Streambank Stabilization and Meadowbrook Lake Dredging project, in the amount of \$1,999,454.13.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Meadowbrook Lake, which is part of the Meadowbrook Lake subdivision, receives surface water from two inlet tributaries on the north end of the lake (the Walled Lake Branch of the Middle Rouge and Ingersol Creek). Sediment has been building up at both tributaries, resulting in the formation of sediment 'islands' at the north end of the lake. Construction activities north of the lake several years ago may have resulted in an influx of sediment into the Middle Rouge tributary. The sediment fan, or 'islands', that have accumulated at the tributaries are likely obstructing the flow of water into the lake, and they have limited the residents' ability to use the lake for recreation, such as fishing. Additionally, the Middle Rouge channel leading into the lake south of Chattman Road has eroded significantly. The channel runs between two homes, with the banks less than 50 feet from either home. Stabilizing the streambank at this location will help reduce bank erosion and sediment loading into the lake and will reduce the threat of a steepening and/or widening channel. The project will involve hydraulically dredging 7,000 cubic yards of sediment from the tributary areas along with stabilization of approximately 230 feet of the Middle Rouge inlet channel south of Chattman Road.

OHM Advisors assisted the Engineering Division with developing engineering design plans for the project. The plans were advertised for public bids on July 18, 2023. One (1) bid was

received and opened on August 8, 2023, following the solicitation period. M-K Construction, the sole bidder, is recommended in the best interest of the City, as it is responsive and complies with all requirements of the bidding instructions. The award recommendation letter including the bid tabulation is attached.


The contract administration and geotechnical engineering services related to this project will be awarded to the following pre-qualified firms using the fee percentages in the Agreements for Professional Engineering Services and Geotechnical Engineering Services for Public Projects. Construction is expected to begin next spring and last approximately 4 months.

Recommendation of Award

Dear Mr. Ben Croy:

A sealed bid for the Middle Rouge Stream Stabilization and Meadowbrook Lake Dredging project was received by the City from one (1) bidder. We have reviewed and checked the bid, and attached the Bid Tabulation for your information. The lowest bidder is as follows:

Contractor	TOTAL BID
M-K Construction Co., Inc.	\$2,071,454.13

The project scope consists of dredging approximately 7000 cubic yards of material within Meadowbrook Lake and approximately 230 feet of stream stabilization along the Walled Lake branch of the Middle Rouge River. The final engineer's estimate of probable construction cost was approximately \$3,190,000.

M-K Construction Co., Inc. is the apparent lowest responsible bidder for this project. OHM Advisors reviewed projects submitted with the bid and performed reference checks. After review of the bid packages, it was identified that the bid received is 35% lower than the engineer's estimate of probable construction cost. Based on the bid received and conversations with references, we believe the bid result is due to the fact that M-K Construction uses little to no sub-contractors.

M-K Construction Co., Inc. provided additional dredging project references to supplement those submitted in the sealed bid. OHM Advisors reviewed the relevant projects submitted and determined that M-K Construction Co., Inc has satisfactorily completed similar projects for southeast Michigan communities. Therefore, we recommend award of this contract to M-K Construction Co., Inc. in the amount of \$1,999,454.13 per the unit prices bid for the project. Please note that this contract award amount is derived from the total bid amount of \$2,071,454.13, less the crew day cost of \$72,000.





when constructions begins, and to Final Completion, including restoration and all punch list items, by November 1, 2025.

The undersigned attaches hereto its Bid security, as required by the Advertisement for Bids and Instructions to Bidders. The undersigned agrees that in case it shall fail to fulfill its obligations under the foregoing Bid, and/or shall fail to furnish bonds, as specified, the OWNER may, at its option determine that the undersigned has abandoned its rights and interests in such Contract and that its Bid security accompanying its Bid; has been forfeited to the said OWNER, but otherwise the Bid security shall be returned to the undersigned upon the execution of the Contract and the acceptance of the bonds.

The undersigned also agrees that for each and every calendar day that he may be in default of Substantial Completion of the Work, within the time specified in this Bid, the OWNER will suffer a damage of FIFTEEN hundred dollars (\$1500.00) per day, and said OWNER shall be compensated therefore at the rate as liquidated damages in accordance with the Agreement.

In submitting this Bid, it is understood that the right is reserved by the OWNER to accept any bid, to reject any or all Bids, and to waive irregularities in bidding in the interest of the OWNER.
