Community Beautification Update

Success! Our native garden installations have come to a close. Through the combined efforts of the City of Novi staff, locally-owned companies, and many WCA volunteers, we were able to accomplish so much in the past two years. Five native trees and approximately 1500 square feet of native plants were added. These plants will provide beauty and environmental gains for years to come. The beautification projects also created intangible benefits, as neighbors became friends while working together towards a common good. Additionally, homeowners are increasingly adding beauty through native flowers to their own yards. In 2022, there are at least 2000 square feet of privately owned native butterfly gardens being installed in the WCA -- with hopefully more to come! While our efforts may seem small, collectively we can make an impact in helping to restore wildlife habitats.

Looking forward, the gardens will continue to need extra care with weeding for the first few years until the plants become more established and denser. We appreciate how residents around most of the islands have volunteered to weed during the summer. The Malott Island, our biggest island, does need some additional volunteers to help care for it these next few years. If you are able to help, please contact any board member to learn more. Also on the horizon are the new benches that will be installed in Sub 2 this summer. And to cap off the warmer months, please be looking for information about our fall beautification event, where we will be doing a final cleanup of the islands before the winter.

In 2023, the aim is to focus on Subdivision 3 for beautification efforts. This part of the Willowbrook Community Association does not have islands we can improve, so efforts will look a little different. For residents of Sub 3, your newsletter is including a survey to get ideas of beautification projects. Please complete and mail it back by August 22nd, so your ideas can be reviewed during our fall general meeting. The fall meeting also is when the 2-year terms of the current members of the Beautification Committee end. We would like to encourage more WCA members to join the Beatification Committee and/or take an active role in planning Sub 3 improvements. While all of us working on the recent projects plan to continue volunteering and caring for our community, we are a little exhausted and need people with fresh energy to take the lead for any new undertakings. Please attend the fall general meeting and/or contact any board member to learn more about how you can help.

It has been a pleasure working on the beautification projects. We thank all of the volunteers who helped with planning, planting, watering, weeding, and encouragement. We look forward to seeing what the future holds!
