SUBJECT: Adoption of Act 51 New Street Resolution accepting portions of Seeley Road and 11 Mile Road as public streets, adding 0.21 miles of roadway to the City's street system.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The primary source of road funding in Michigan comes from fuel and vehicle tax revenue collected by the state and then distributed to road agencies according to formulas established by Public Act 51 of 1951. The distribution to each County, City and Village is based on the number of centerline miles that are certified on each road network. The "Act 51 map" represents the certified road network and serves as the basis for funding. Therefore, every road that is maintained by the City of Novi should be formally accepted and certified to maximize the distribution of gas and weight tax revenue to the City. Each road agency has an annual opportunity to add newly accepted streets to the official map. Any newly accepted streets or streets that are missing from the map are then included in the annual submittal to the state. Novi's certified mileage as of July 1, 2013 was 39.42 miles of major road and 144.20 miles of local streets, for a total of 183.62 miles.

A staff review of the most recent Act 51 map revealed two sections of road that have been actively maintained by the City of Novi since incorporation in 1969 were missing from the map. In the mid-1990s, a section of 11 Mile Road (located east of Meadowbrook Road) was realigned a couple of hundred feet to the south by the Michigan Department of Transportation to construct a new ramp from eastbound I-96 to M-5 North, which was being constructed to 12 Mile Road at that time. As shown on the attached historical aerials, a section of the original 11 Mile Road along with a section of Seeley Road north of the new alignment of 11 Mile Road remained in use following construction. The City has actively maintained these road segments since before the realignment of 11 Mile Road, and they have been in existence since before incorporation of the City.

In order to add the potions of 11 Mile Road and Seeley Road to the Act 51 funding map, City Council must adopt a resolution formally accepting the streets as public.


