#### **BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

This project involves upgrades to the Department of Public Works facility to comply with the City's MS4 permit (MS4 refers to a Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System). The goal of the MS4 program is to reduce the discharge of pollutants to lakes, streams, etc. through proper management of facilities, so pollutants are not transported to surface water during rain events. The proposed improvements include the construction of a "Vactor Station" and reconstruction of a portion of the existing DPW parking lot, as shown on the attached figure.

The installation of a Vactor Station would allow for proper temporary storage of spoils from the City's two vacuum trucks used for cleaning storm sewer catch basins, maintenance of the sanitary sewer system, and street sweeping activities. The material collected by these trucks typically has a water content higher than what is permitted to be disposed of at the landfill. The Vactor Station will provide a method to properly dewater the material, which will drain to the sanitary sewer. Once dewatered, the material can then be loaded and disposed of offsite at the landfill.

The parking lot improvements will include reconstruction of the lot south of the DPW building, reconstruction of a portion of the existing entrance drive, and the construction of a new entrance drive aligned with the southern portion of the parking lot. The parking lot improvements will allow for proper storm water management within the parking lot, including the storm water runoff associated with the salt storage area. Proper storm water management can eliminate the potential for runoff to reach the nearby Bishop Creek to the south of the site.

OHM Advisors, the City's Engineering consultant, assisted the Department of Public Works with developing the plans for this project. The plans were advertised for public bids on August 23, 2019. Following the solicitation period, staff received and opened five (5) bids on September 12, 2019. Fonson Company's bid is recommended as being in the best interest of the City as it is responsive, is the low bidder, and complies with all of the requirements of the bidding instructions. OHM's award recommendation letter including the bid tabulation dated September 16, 2019 is attached. A summary of the bid tabulation is as follows:

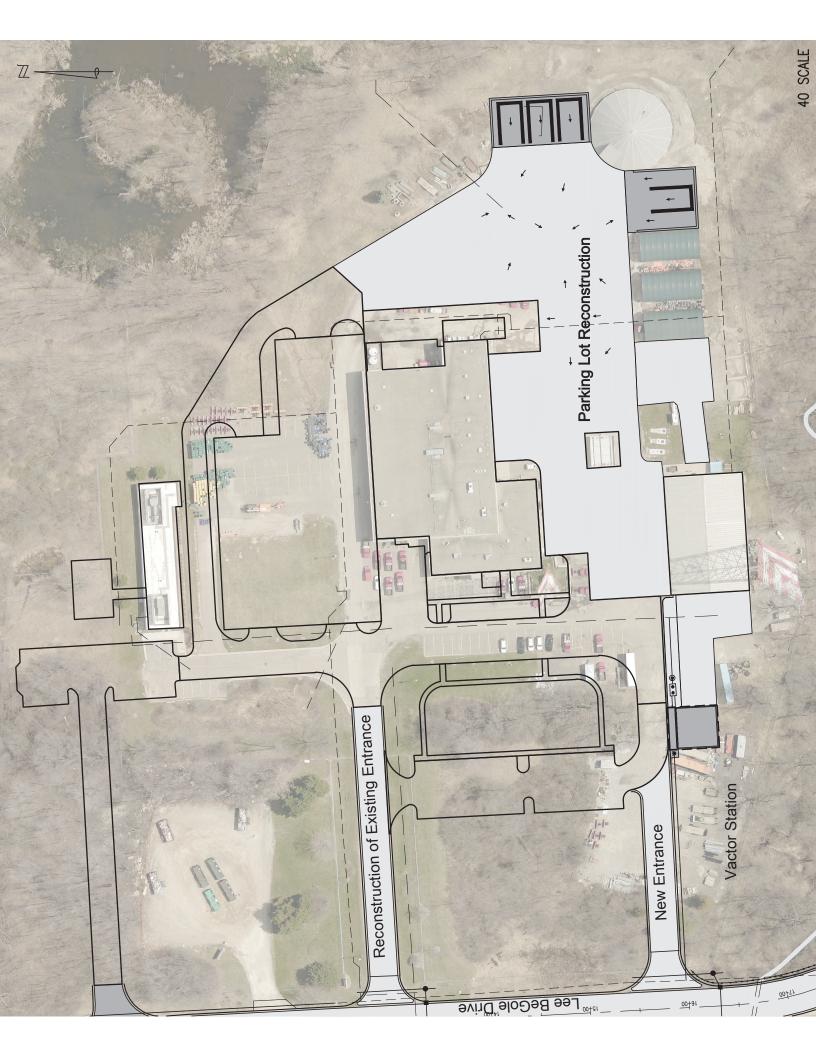
Given the late-season award of this project, an Early Finish Incentive was included with this bid as motivation for the contractor to complete the project this construction season. Fonson's bid included a reasonable incentive payment of \$24,000, which they will receive if they meet the early completion date of November 15, 2019, as opposed to the standard completion date of June 26, 2020.

The construction engineering services and geotechnical engineering services related to this project will be awarded to the following pre-qualified firms using the fee percentages in the Agreements for Professional Engineering Services and Geotechnical Engineering Services for Public Projects.

Recommendation of Award

Dear Mr. Croy:

On Thursday, September 12, 2019 at 2:00 pm, the City received sealed bids for a proposed vactor station and parking lot improvements at the City DPW facility. Included in the bid was an alternate bid option for an early finish incentive bid if the project were substantially completed this year. The City received proposals from five (5) bidders. The summary of bidders, and their total base bid amounts and alternate incentive amount are listed below. The bid amounts of all work items from the bidders are summarized in the attached bid tabulation. The Engineer's Opinion of Construction Cost for this project was estimated to be \$1,428,950 (not including crew day cost or contingency). Please note that the total bid amounts listed below in the table do include the anticipated cost of crew days for the project.

The project scope consists of upgrades to the DPW facility including construction of a vactor dumping station and reconstruction of a portion of the existing DPW parking lot. The parking lot work will include the reconstruction of the existing lot south and southeast of the DPW building, reconstruction of the existing main entrance drive, and construction of a new entrance drive aligned with the south portion of the lot. Concrete pads will be constructed around the existing salt dome for material storage and to contain storm water runoff in that location. The work to be completed under this contract includes the furnishing of materials, equipment, and labor necessary to complete the proposed work, in accordance with the contract documents.

Fonson Company, Inc. (Fonson), located in Brighton, Michigan, is the apparent low bidder. OHM Advisors contacted a sampling of references provided by Fonson. Based on our communication with these references, Fonson is capable of successfully performing the work outlined in the bidding documents, and references provided favorable feedback regarding their experience on similar projects. We also understand the City of Novi is working directly with Fonson on a road construction project and has had favorable experiences.



We therefore recommend award of the Vactor Station and DPW Parking Lot Improvements project to Fonson Company, Inc., for their alternative bid including the early finish incentive, in an estimated contract award amount of \$1,497,418.10. Please note that this contract award amount is derived from the total bid amount of \$1,536,418.10, less the crew day cost of \$63,000 plus the early finish incentive of \$24,000.

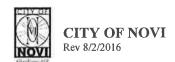

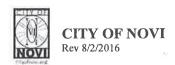
