SUBJECT: Approval to award a construction contract for Town Center Reconstruction—Contract 2 (11 Mile to Crescent) project to Fonson Company, Inc., the lowest responsible bidder, in the amount of \$630,245, subject to final review and approval of form of gareement by City Manager's office and the City Attorney.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

This project includes the reconstruction of Town Center Drive from Eleven Mile to Crescent Boulevard, Improvements to the sidewalks and ramps, as well as other minor improvements, will be completed within the project limits. This portion of the road was scheduled to be completed last year along with the portion of Town Center Drive between Eleven Mile and Grand River. However, the work could not be completed by the end of the construction season.

A change order removing the incomplete portions of the project from Contract 1 (awarded to a different contractor) was issued in December 2014 in the deductive amount of \$664,895. The incomplete work is now being recommended for award as Town Contract 2 includes Town Center Drive from Center Reconstruction—Contract 2. Crescent Boulevard to and including the Eleven Mile intersection as shown on the attached map.

The reconstruction of the road provides the opportunity to include an interlayer and geogrid, both of which are geosynthetic paving materials designed to extend the service life of the pavement. The interlayer is constructed of a fiberglass mesh embedded into high performance polyester mats and is placed between asphalt lifts to provide additional strength and resist reflective cracking, while also preventing moisture infiltration into the pavement structure. The geogrid is placed within the aggregate base layer to reduce subgrade stresses by spreading point loads over a larger area (i.e., the "snowshoe effect").

Ten bids were received and opened on February 11, 2015 following a public bid solicitation period. The lowest responsible bidder is Fonson Company. Fonson's bid is recommended as being in the best interest of the City as it is responsive (i.e., Fonson has complied with all requirements of the bidding instructions) and it is the lowest price of the bids submitted by contractors considered responsible (i.e. able to complete the work). The attached memo dated February 13, 2015 provides additional discussion in this regard.

(SDA's award recommendation letter including the bid tabulation dated February 13, 2015 is attached). A summary of the ten bids is as follows:


The construction engineering services award is proposed for consideration elsewhere on this agenda. It is anticipated that this project will be completed by summer 2015.

Dear Mr. Croy:

On February 12, 2015 at 2:00 p.m., construction bids were opened and publicly read at the City of Novi Civic Center for the Town Center Drive Reconstruction Contract 2. The project includes removal of the existing concrete road and replacement with new asphalt construction.

The City Clerk's office received ten (10) sealed bids for this project, with each bidder considered to be responsive having submitted a bid compliant with all requirements. The lowest responsible bidder, Fonson Company, Inc., submitted a total bid of \$655,845.22. Following the bid opening, Spalding DeDecker reviewed all of the bids received, verified the calculations, and prepared the bid tabulation for the project (attached).

Based on a review of experience and references provided, Spalding DeDecker finds that Fonson Company, Inc. is qualified to perform the required construction.

It is our recommendation that the project be awarded to the lowest responsible bidder, Fonson Company, Inc., for the Town Center Drive Reconstruction Contract 2 in the amount of \$630,245.22, which is the total bid of \$655,845.22 minus \$25,600.00 for crew days bid.

Upon award by the City Council, our office will coordinate the completion of the Contract Agreement, Bonds, and Insurance information with Fonson Company, Inc..
