We especially appreciate those of you who volunteered to help! In the Sub 3 survey, every single respondent strongly agreed that they would like to have more residents know about Novi's free tree planting program. Attention all WCA Homeowners – if you would like to have a FREE large tree planted in the public right of way of your yard (the part of your property along the street) please contact Novi's Forestry Department for more details (248-735-5640 or ksalowich@cityofnovi.org). The Novi Forester will evaluate your property. If adding a tree is appropriate, he will recommend specific trees, coordinate getting that tree and then have it planted for you – all for FREE. That's hundreds of dollars in savings and a beautiful investment! They have limited supplies, so please contact Novi Forestry ASAP to reserve your tree for the fall or spring planting.
