NEIGHBORS HELPING NEIGHBORS -- TOOLS!

Most people have things around their house that they aren't using. Maybe a tool or something that they bought for that one thing and now it's sitting in the garage or basement or shed.

You'd share it with a neighbor if they needed it . . . but they don't know you have it. **Well . . . now there is a way!**

The **Neighbors-Helping-Neighbors team** has put together a simple system to put people that have a thing . . . together with someone who needs a thing.

Use the form to list that thing you are willing to share (tub drain extractor, sled, sink wrench, wheel-barrow) or check the sheet before heading out to Ace or Home Depot to buy something new that you'll never use again. Reach out to the owner to see if you can borrow it.

One of the most important jobs in the association is the treasurer. They receive/record all the dues sent in via check* and cut checks for our expenses. It is also one of two positions that are paid; \$500 a year. (The other paid position is the secretary.)

Our current Treasurer has had to step down and we are looking for a replacement. The position requires a monthly meeting where we review the books and whatever time during the month to manage them and handle title company requests, resident inquiries, etc.
