BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The Novi Ice Arena flooring has undergone a phased approach in replacement over the past few years with this being the final.

The proposed scope calls for the removal and replacement of the rubber flooring at both west staircases and all four landings in the facility. We will be using Norament Grano Stair tread with Matching landing tile that is the exact product that has lasted over 15 years in the arena with great wear history. We are also including both alternates that include the installation of a walk-off carpet in both vestibules, and additional skate-approved flooring for walkways to ice surfaces.

The Invitation for Bids for the Novi Ice Arena rubber flooring replacement project was posted on the Michigan Intergovernmental Trade Network (MITN) website. A mandatory pre-bid meeting was held on site on May 11th, 2016 which was attended by four firms. We received three bids in response to the Invitation for Bids.

RECOMMENDED ACTION: Approval to award the Ice Arena rubber flooring replacement project to City Carpet and Flooring Inc., the low bidder, in the amount of \$18,650 and both Alternate1 and 2 for \$11,350.

SPECIFICATIONS

PROJECT OVERVIEW

This project includes replacement of all existing flooring and wall base on north stairs and landings; south landings at the Novi Ice Arena.

Alternate #1 is for installation of walk-off carpet in both vestibule entrances. Please provide product specifications and samples.

Alternate #2 is for installation of Skate-approved flooring at all four entrances of ice surface. Please provide product specifications and samples.

MANDATORY PRE-BID MEETING/SITE INSPECTION

All bidders are required to examine the premise to determine the amount of work to be done in accordance to the specifications during the scheduled walkthrough.

GENERAL SCOPE

- 1. Remove and dispose (haul away) existing flooring and wall base
- 2. Scarify and skim floor for floor prep
- 3. Install new rubber flooring tile and tread
- 4. Install new stair tread
- 5. Install new wall base
- 6. Provide extra materials equal to 2% of quantity of flooring. Properly label and package extra materials. Deliver to Owner's designated storage.
- 7. No furniture/equipment moving required.





City Carpet and Flooring installed 75,000 yards of carpet, 3,500 yards of special heat welded sheet vinyl, 13,000 square feet of rubber tile, 10,000 square feet of VCT and 1,600 stair treads in the Compuware World Headquarters.



The most impressive flooring work was done in the Child Daycare Center. The vinyl designs had to be laid down, measured and designed by hand with very few measurements denoted by the architect on the blue prints. The tight schedule coupled with the challenges of working in the midst of four or five other trades, made these areas quite demanding on City Carpet and Flooring's technicians.

However they were successful, installing the colorful designs with superior service and quality expected from City Carpet and Flooring, leading them to this prestigious award.
