SUBJECT: Approval to award a construction contract for the 2015 Sanitary Sewer Manhole Rehabilitation Project to Culy Contracting, Inc., the low bidder, in the amount of \$228,390.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

This project includes the rehabilitation of sanitary sewer manholes in the following subdivisions: North Hills, Timber Ridge, Westridge Downs and Orchard Ridge. This project is part of the ongoing Capacity Management, Operations and Maintenance (CMOM) program to actively maintain the sanitary sewer collection system to reduce system failures and eliminate infiltration and inflow into the collection system. The project was developed after inspection and evaluation of 130 manholes within the project area to determine necessary rehabilitation techniques for defects that were identified as part of the inspections. The rehabilitation of the manholes involves rebuilding of the upper portion of the manhole and sealing the manholes with an external shroud to prevent inflow and infiltration from entering the manhole, or sealing the entire manhole to prevent inflow and infiltration from entering the manhole through the cone and riser sections of manhole.

Four bids were received and opened on January 14, 2015 following a public bid solicitation period. The lowest bidder is Culy Contracting. Culy's bid is recommended as being in the best interest of the City as it is responsive (i.e., Culy has complied with all requirements of the bidding instructions) and it is the lowest price. (SDA's award recommendation letter including the bid tabulation dated January 19, 2015 is attached). A summary of the four bids is as follows:



Dear Mr. Croy:

On January 14, 2015 at 2:00 p.m., construction bids were opened and publicly read at the City of Novi Civic Center for the 2015 Sanitary Sewer Manhole Rehabilitation Project. The project includes improvements to 133 manholes in the Orchard Ridge, North Hills, Timber Ridge, and Westridge Downs Subdivisions.

The City Clerk's office received four (4) sealed bids for this project, with each bidder considered to be responsive having submitted a bid compliant with all requirements. The apparent low bidder, Culy Contracting, Inc., submitted a total bid of \$250,790.00. Following the bid opening, Spalding DeDecker reviewed all of the bids received, verified the calculations, and prepared the bid tabulation for the project (attached).

Based on a review of experience and references provided, Spalding DeDecker finds that Culy Contracting, Inc. is qualified to perform the required construction.

It is our recommendation that the project be awarded to the low bidder, Culy Contracting, Inc. for the 2015 Sanitary Sewer Manhole Rehabilitation project in the amount of \$228,390.00, which is the total bid of \$250,790.00 minus \$22,400.00 for crew days bid.

Upon award by the City Council, our office will coordinate the completion of the Contract Agreement, Bonds, and Insurance information with Culy Contracting, Inc.

The undersigned agrees that in case it shall fail to fulfill its obligations under the foregoing Bid, and/or shall fail to furnish bonds, as specified, the OWNER may, at its option determine
