ORDINANCE NO. 25-81.25

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CITY OF NOVI CODE OF **CHAPTER** "TRAFFIC AND ORDINANCES, 33, VEHICLES", ARTICLE II, "UNIFORM TRAFFIC CODE." DIVISION 2, "ADDITIONAL REGULATIONS," SUBDIVISION 5, "STOPPING, STANDING, PARKING," **SECTION** "PARKING IN A MANNER THAT OBSTRUCTS TRAFFIC; VIOLATION AS CIVIL INFRACTION," IN ORDER TO ADD STANDARDS RELATING TO PARKING ON NARROW STREETS AND IN SPECIAL PLACES.

THE CITY OF NOVI ORDAINS:

PART I. That Chapter 33, "Traffic and Motor Vehicles," Article II, "Uniform Traffic Code," Division 2, "Additional Regulations," Subdivision 5, "Stopping, Standing, Parking," Section 33-501, "Parking in a manner that obstructs traffic; violation as civil infraction," is hereby added to read as follows in its entirety:

SUBDIVISION 5. STOPPING, STANDING, PARKING

Sec. 33-501. Parking in a manner that obstructs traffic; violation as civil infraction.

- (a) A person shall not park any vehicle on a street in a manner that leaves an insufficient width of the roadway available for free movement of a vehicular traffic, including for garbage trucks, snowplows, and police, fire, and emergency vehicles. Less than 10 feet in width shall in all cases be considered a restriction on the free movement of vehicular traffic. On streets that have less than 24 feet in pavement width, where vehicles parked across from each other on opposite sides of the street will potentially obstruct traffic, or will leave less than 10 feet between vehicles, a person shall, to the extent it is safe and available for use (e.g., flat surface or improved with gravel or stone or similar treatment) use the shoulder of the roadway within the public right-of-way, or a portion of it, to ensure a sufficient width for free movement. If parked on the opposite side of the street across from a driveway entrance, the vehicle shall be parked as far off the pavement as possible and safe, in order to allow unobstructed egress from the driveway. The City Engineer is authorized to post signage reflecting the requirements of this Section where they determine it appropriate to do so.
- (b) A person who violates this section is responsible for a civil infraction and/or impoundment.

PART II.

<u>Severability</u>. Should any section, subdivision, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance be declared by the courts to be invalid, the validity of the Ordinance as a whole, or in part, shall not be affected other than the part invalidated.

PART III.

<u>Savings Clause</u>. The amendment of the Novi Code of Ordinances set forth in this Ordinance does not affect or impair any act done, offense committed, or right accruing, accrued, or acquired or liability, penalty, forfeiture or punishment, pending or incurred prior to the amendment of the Novi Code of Ordinances set forth in this Ordinance.

PART IV.

Repealer. All other Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed only to the extent necessary to give this Ordinance full force and effect.

PART V.

<u>Effective Date</u>. The provisions of this Ordinance are ordered to take effect following publication in the manner prescribed by the Charter of the City of Novi.

PART VI.

<u>Adoption</u>. This ordinance is hereby declared to have been adopted by the Novi City Council in a meeting thereof duly held and called on the 25th day of August, 2025, in order to be given publication in the manner prescribed by the Charter of the City of Novi.
