SUBJECT: Consideration of approval to award the construction contract for the 2020 Sanitary Pipe and Manhole Rehabilitation project, to Pipeline Management Company, the low-bidder, in the amount of \$1,031,304, and amend the budget.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: The Water and Sewer Division has recently completed a five-year program involving the inspection of sanitary sewer manholes and pipes. The City of Novi received \$1,104,646 in grant funding (75% of project costs for inspection) from the Michigan Department of Environmental Quality (now EGLE) through a program intended to assist with Stormwater, Asset Management, and Wastewater (SAW) projects (refer to attached Memo for additional information related to the grant program).

With the SAW grant inspection program completed, OHM Advisors and staff reviewed the results to confirm the necessary rehabilitation locations and repair techniques within the project area. OHM and staff then developed a program scope to address defects observed in the sanitary sewer manholes and pipes. The rehabilitation of the sanitary sewer infrastructure is based on factors such as severity and criticality of the defects. The attached map shows the area included in the inspection program, and highlights the manholes and pipes identified to be addressed. The repairs will be completed utilizing methods, including grouting, pipe and manhole liners, replacement, and other rehabilitation methods. Following this project, a second phase will be included in the City's capital improvement program. OHM Advisors assisted the Engineering Division with developing the engineering design plans for this project. The plans were advertised for public bids on May 15,

2020. Four (4) bids were received and opened on June 25, 2020, following the solicitation period. Pipeline Management Company's bid is recommended in the best interest of the City, as it is responsive and complies with all of the requirements of the bidding instructions. The award recommendation letter including the bid tabulation is attached. A summary of the four bids are as follows:



The construction engineering services related to this project will be awarded to the following pre-qualified firm. It was determined that a reduced inspection effort would be needed for this type of rehabilitation work to be completed, and therefore a crew day line item was not included in the construction bid. Instead, a separate scope was developed specific to this type of inspection as described in the enclosed OHM proposal dated July 16, 2020. The contract administration fee was calculated using the percentages in the Agreement for Professional Engineering Services for Public Projects. No geotechnical engineering services will be required for this project.

On Thursday, June 25, 2020 at 1:00 pm, the City received sealed bids for the rehabilitation of select sanitary sewer manholes and pipes. The City received proposals from four (4) bidders. The summary of bidders, and their total bid amounts are listed below. We have summarized the bid amounts of all work items from the bidders in the attached bid tabulation.

The project scope consists of manhole and pipe rehabilitation, which includes major items such as cleaning, televising, grouting, and lining work. The project also includes other miscellaneous work related to the impact of the sanitary sewer such as manhole adjustment, road pavement replacement, driveway approach replacement, and site restoration. The work to be completed under this contract includes the furnishing of materials, equipment, and labor necessary to complete the proposed work, in accordance with the contract documents.

Pipeline Management Company, located in Milford, Michigan is the apparent low bidder. OHM Advisors has previous experience working with this Contractor on projects similar in scope to this work, and they received positive references. We spoke with Pipeline Management Company directly regarding the scope of work and their unit prices for the project, and they indicated that they are ready to execute the work on this contract per the as-bid documents.

We therefore recommend award of the 2020 Manhole and Pipe Rehabilitation project to Pipeline Management Company for their bid in an estimated contract award amount of \$1,031,304.00.

RE: 2020 Manhole & Pipe Rehabilitation Scope of Services for Construction Phase Efforts

Dear Mr. Croy:

Per your request, the following outlines our proposed scope of services to perform manhole and pipe rehabilitation as part of the current project that had a Contractor bid opening on June 25, 2020. The low bidder on the project is Pipeline Management Company from Milford with an estimated low bid price of \$1,031,304. This summary includes our project understanding, proposed scope of work, assumptions, schedule, and fee.

PROJECT UNDERSTANDING

It is our understanding that the City of Novi wishes to continue with this project at the estimated low bid price and have OHM Advisors perform contract administration and construction engineering services during the work. It is our intention to provide those services consistent with the scope of services outlined below.

SCOPE OF SERVICES

The following outlines our work plan to accomplish the scope of services for this project:

- Provide contract administration services consistent with our current Agreement for Professional Engineering Services between OHM Advisors and City of Novi dated December 18, 2017, Exhibit A.
- Provide field inspection services consistent with the table provided below under our Inspection Fee Summary, and Exhibit A of the Agreement for Professional Engineering Services. OHM Advisors will provide inspection based on Contractor work activity as outlined in our table, or as otherwise requested by the City.

ASSUMPTIONS

The following summarizes our assumptions associated with this proposal:

- We assume that the Contractor will complete the work within 180 calendar days. We also assume that the amount of Contractor work days will be consistent with our fee summary table outlined below for 130 days.
- We assume that the amount of effort needed for a specific work task will be consistent with the number of crew days outlined below. If the Contractor requires additional supervision due to the quality of their work or if certain tasks require re-work, this is assumed to be additional effort above and beyond this scope of work.
- We assume the City will provide a Notice to Proceed to the Contractor within the next 60 days.
- We anticipate that the project may require a seasonal shut down to complete all work under the contract documents. In that case, OHM Advisors efforts will be suspended during the seasonal shut down by the Contractor, and resume in spring of 2021.



SCHEDULE

We anticipate that the Contractor will complete the work outlined in the contract documents within 180 calendar days from the time of Notice to Proceed by the City. It is likely that work under this contract would be completed in the early summer of 2021.

FEE SUMMARY

Regarding the Contract Administration fee, we are requesting a fee consistent with our Agreement for Engineering Services Agreement, Exhibit B. Based on the estimated contract amount of \$1,031,304, the contract administration fee would be calculated as 4% of that contract amount. Therefore, the requested Contract Administration Fee is \$41,252 as a fixed fee.

The following table summarizes our assumptions related to the field inspection effort on this project, based on assumed Contractor efforts for major items of work and anticipated crew day efforts. We propose this fee as a Not-to-exceed amount, billed based on actual time spent.



In 2015, the City of Novi received grant funding from the Michigan Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ) through a program intended to assist with Stormwater, Asset Management, and Wastewater (SAW) projects. Two grants for sanitary sewer system related tasks were successfully applied for; one submitted by the Department of Public Works' Water and Sewer Division, and one submitted by the Oakland County Water Resources Commissioner (for work related to the portion of the sanitary sewer system they maintain on behalf of Novi). The grant funding under the SAW programs allowed for a 90% grant (with 10% local match) for the first million, and a 75% grant (25% local match) for the second million. Between the two grants, **Novi received \$1,104,646** in grant funding (with a match of \$140,180) for sanitary sewer system inspection, asset management planning, and construction projects.




Figure 1: SAW Grant Project Area

Figure 1 shows the areas inspected during this five-year program (2013-2018). Even though the grant was awarded in 2015, work dating back through 2013 was considered eligible, allowing pipe inspections and manhole repairs already completed to be reimbursed. The one primary program limitation was that infrastructure involved must be 20+ years old to be eligible for the grant funding, which meant the areas investigated fell within the older areas of the city.

The tasks completed during the SAW grant program included the following:

- Televising, cleaning, and inspection of sanitary sewer pipe this work was completed by Water and Sewer Division staff, the City's contractor (Metro Environmental) and Oakland County staff; 546,678 linear feet (103 miles) of pipe was inspected during the program.
- Condition assessment of sanitary sewer manhole structures 1,673 manholes were inspected during the program.
- Manhole Rehabilitation 133 sanitary sewer manholes were repaired or reconstructed as necessary throughout four subdivisions.
- Asset Management Plan This plan was developed as a tool to help implement a cost-effective program for future maintenance of the sanitary sewer system.

Two reports summarizing the findings and recommendations resulting from the SAW program were developed by OHM Advisors, the consultant used by both Novi and

Oakland County for this work. The reports outline short-term and long-term plans for infrastructure repair, as well as an asset management plan.

Based on the findings summarized in the two reports, future projects will be developed to complete the repairs identified during the inspection. Some projects have already been planned for in the City's Capital Improvement Program in anticipation of the upcoming work. These projects will be completed following a prioritization analysis based on the severity of the defect and the consequence of failure for each segment. In general, the city's sanitary sewer infrastructure is in good condition. This is encouraging news given that the area inspected contains some of the city's oldest infrastructure.
