SUBJECT: Approval to award a construction contract for the Eight Mile Road Pathway (between Beck and Garfield) to Merlo Construction, the low bidder, in the amount of \$460,669, subject to final review and approval of form of agreement by City Manager's office and the City Attorney.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The purpose of this project is to construct an 8-foot wide pathway along the north side of Eight Mile Road between Beck Road and the crosswalk located west of the Garfield Road and Eight Mile Road intersection to complete the pathway gaps in this area. The existing segments of pathway along the frontage of Maybury Park Estates and Tuscany Reserve would remain in place with minor modifications to meet Americans with Disability Act (ADA) requirements. The attached map shows the location of the proposed pathway.

The project was bid as a base bid and two alternates. The base bid includes the construction of all pathway segments along the north side of Eight Mile Road, except across the frontage of the proposed Ballantyne subdivision (which is Alternate 1) and the proposed Dunhill Park subdivision (which is Alternate 2). The alternates were included to give flexibility at the time of award should there be movement toward developing one or both of the sites or if the bid prices exceed the budget.

Six bids were received and opened on September 17, 2015 following a public bid solicitation period. Merlo Construction was the low bidder, and after review of Merlo's bid it is recommended as being in the best interest of the City as it is responsive (i.e., Merlo has complied with all requirements of the bidding instructions) and the unit prices are in-line with the engineer's estimate. Merlo has successfully worked as a subcontractor on various City projects over the years. (Spalding DeDecker's award recommendation letter including the bid tabulation dated September 21, 2015 is attached). A summary of the bid received is as follows:

The budget for this project is \$572,326, of which \$30,000 was previously awarded for design engineering and \$47,223 is being considered elsewhere on this agenda for construction engineering, leaving \$495,046 available for construction. In order to construct the base bid and both alternates, an additional \$152,000 would need to be allocated. Staff is recommending the award of Alternate 1 (Ballantyne frontage sidewalk) and the base bid at this time. Singh, the developer of Ballantyne, has indicated that although there is an approved site plan for the project, there are no immediate plans to construct the development. Given the uncertainty of when this connection to the Eight Mile crosswalk would be constructed and the minimal cost to complete Alternate 1, staff is recommending it be awarded at this time.

Alternative 2 is costly to construct because of poor soils in the area. The Dunhill Park development will be appearing in front of Planning Commission on September 30 for consideration of a concept plan. Since development of the sidewalk along the frontage of the proposed development is costly and development may occur within a year, staff is not recommending award of Alternate 2 at this time. If it is later determined that the Dunhill Park development will not occur, alternate 2 could be awarded as a change order in the future.

It is anticipated that this project will commence this fall and would be completed by summer 2016.

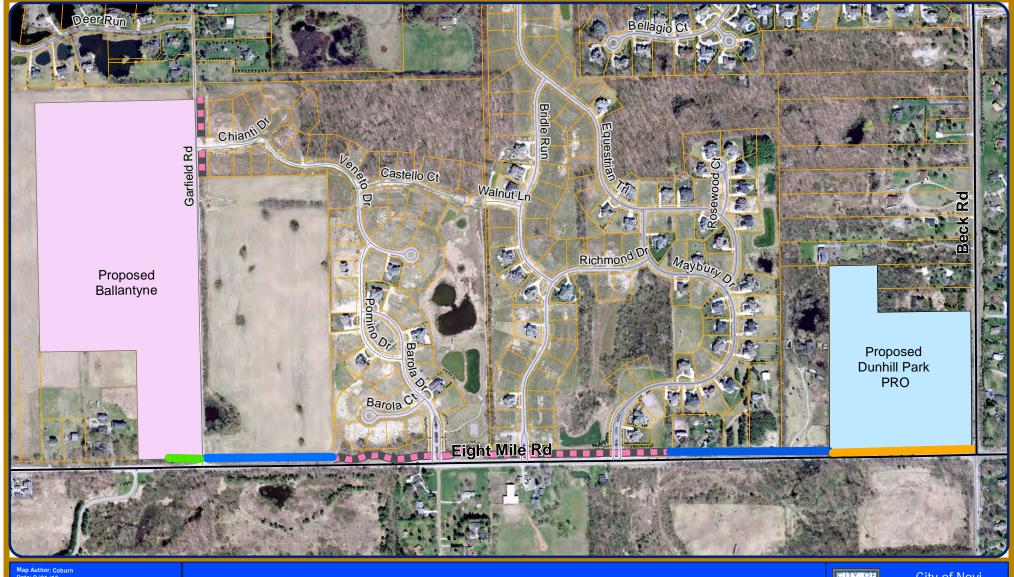

On September 17, 2015 at 2:00 p.m., construction bids were opened and publicly read at the City of Novi Civic Center for the 8 Mile Road Pathway project. The project includes placement of concrete pathway along the north side of 8 Mile Road between Garfield Road and Beck Road.

The City Clerk's office received six (6) sealed bids for this project, with each bidder considered to be responsive having submitted a bid compliant with all requirements. The apparent low bidder, Merlo Construction Co. submitted a total bid (including alternates 1 and 2) of \$653,455.25. Following the bid opening, Spalding DeDecker reviewed all of the bids received, verified the calculations, and prepared the bid tabulation for the project (attached). Based on a review of experience and references provided, Spalding DeDecker finds that Merlo Construction Co. is qualified to perform the required construction.

It is our recommendation that the project be awarded to the low bidder, Merlo Construction Co., for the 8 Mile Road Pathway project for one of the following scopes:

Base Bid in the amount of \$440,152.25 (Total bid of \$454,872.25 minus \$14,720.00 for crew days.)

Base Bid plus Alternate 1 in the amount of \$460,669.25 (Total bid of \$477,949.25 minus \$17,280.00 for crew days.)

Base Bid plus Alternates 1 and 2 in the amount of \$627,855.25 (Total bid of \$653,455.25 minus \$25,600.00 for crew days.)

Upon award by the City Council, our office will coordinate the completion of the Contract Agreement, Bonds, and Insurance information with Merlo Construction Co.

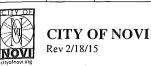
