Community Beautification Update

When our neighborhood lost longtime Subdivision 2 resident Tom Marcus in mid-June, it felt like a wave of sadness swept through the WCA. He was a friend... more like family... to everyone he knew. Mr. Marcus took so much pride in his city and in his neighborhood. If you happened to call his home phone, while he was away, it said "I'm out walking the neighborhood right now, but I should be back in a little while...". His walks were much more than exercise. He would check on his neighbors, share a story (or two), and help to create a more caring community. The Willowbrook Community Association truly was so lucky to have Mr. Marcus as our neighbor and as a role model. Although he is physically gone, his legacy of kindness and pride in his community continues. Thank you to Mr. Marcus and to everyone who helps to make our neighborhood a more beautiful place, both in measurable and immeasurable ways.

Recap of Recent Events:

Spring Beautification Event

6 island, 8 adults, 3 preschoolers and less than 4 hours later – we were able to do a thorough cleanup of the neighborhood gardens. The flowers and sedges are becoming denser, so there was less room for weeds (yay). Some of the sedges had grown taller than the flowers, so we cut them back. We did not add mulch because our goal is for the native plants to fill in completely. You may notice some dry leaves in the gardens – that is intentional. Leaving the leaves provides nutrients to the flowers and shelter for insects (such as some butterflies that overwinter in them each year). Thank you to everyone who volunteered!

Read Box Storytime

We held our first Read Box Storytime at Brookfarm Park (next to Sub 3). It was a beautiful way to celebrate our new community resource. We read about and preformed yoga stretches using a children's yoga book. The story "A Good Place" was a colorful way to talk about the importance of taking care for our insects. I think all of the children (and adults) were impressed by our guest reading from a very talented WCA 5-year-old! We even had activity sheets, popsicles, chalk and a great time running in Brookfarm Park. Thank you to everyone who came and an extra special thanks to Rana and Roukaya who will be helping to run the event next year!


