SUBJECT: Approval to award a construction contract for the Novi Road North Pressure Reducing Valve Vault Upgrades project to Reliance Building Company, the low bidder, in the amount of \$64,600.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

In order to maintain reliable operations of the water system, the City of Novi Water and Sewer Division proposes to construct upgrades to the Novi Road North pressure reducing valve (PRV) vault. Previous inspections of the valve vault indicate that the existing steel structure is in need of rehabilitation and that all electrical and mechanical equipment is in need of replacement. In addition, supervisory control and data acquisition (SCADA) upgrades are needed at the site to allow Water and Sewer Division staff to remotely monitor the site operations. A location map of the proposed project site is provided as an attachment.

Following in-house project design efforts and a public bid solicitation period, one (1) bid for the proposed project was received from Reliance Building Company on August 19, 2014 in the amount of \$64,600. Although only one bid was received for the proposed project, the Reliance Building Company bid has been determined to be acceptable after review of the bid as compared to industry standard costs and the engineer's opinion of probable cost. The Reliance Building Company bid is recommended as being in the best interest of the City as it is respnsive to the specific requirements of the bidding instructions. The recommendation letter, which contains the bid and engineer's opinion of probably cost, is provided as an attachment.

Construction is scheduled to begin in late-Fall 2014 and completion is anticipated in late spring of 2015. The construction contract calls for final restoration of the site to be complete by May $15^{\rm lh}$, 2015 in time for the high water usage season in the summer.

Sealed bids for the Novi Rd. – North PRV Upgrades were received and publicly read aloud on August 19, 2014. Bid proposals were received from one (1) bidder, Reliance Building Company, which submitted a bid in the amount of \$64,600.00. The Engineer's Opinion of Construction Cost for this project was estimated to be \$127,850.00. The bid and engineer's opinion of probable cost are attached for reference.

The project consists of the maintenance upgrades to the mechanical and electrical systems within the Novi-Rd. North PRV, restoration of the interior steel surfaces of the vault, and SCADA system upgrades to the site. The work to be done under this Contract includes the furnishing of materials, equipment, and labor necessary to complete the proposed work, as well as all necessary restoration in accordance with the specifications.

Having reviewed the proposal from Reliance Building Company, we find no irregularities in their proposal. We have also contacted numerous references to verify their qualifications. These references include the following:






