MDOT PROJECTS



I-96 Freeway Flex Route

Construction operations are ongoing on the I-96 Freeway Flex Route project.

EB I-96, Kent Lake to Wixom, will have two lanes open through the late fall.

The following ramps will be reopened on these dates: SB Wixom to EB I-96 on Saturday, September 16; EB I-96 to Novi Road on Saturday, October 14; SB/NB Novi Road to EB I-96 on Saturday, October 14; and SB Beck Road to EB I-96 on Wednesday, November 15.

Rebuilding Michigan I-696 Project

The following ramps will remain closed through late fall of 2023: NB Telegraph to EB I-696; EB I-696 to American Drive; SB Orchard Lake to EB I-696; NB Orchard Lake to WB I-696; and WB M-5 to WB I-96.

RCOC PROJECTS



10 Mile Widening and Rehabilitation

Ten Mile Road remains open to eastbound-only traffic between Meadowbrook and Haggerty Roads. The Road Commission of Oakland County is currently paving the road and plans to reopen the road at the end of next week.

Novi Road Rehabilitation


Novi Road between Nine Mile and 10 Mile Roads remains open to southbound-only traffic only. RCOC is back out conducting road construction work in the area while they still wait for utility companies to remove lines in the area. Northbound traffic on Novi Road is anticipated to open late this fall.

2023 Simple Asphalt Resurfacing

RCOC plans to mill and pave 14 Mile Road from East Lake Drive to Haggerty Road later this construction season. RCOC is still determining a start date for this project.

GLWA 54-INCH TRANSMISSION WATER MAIN



13 Mile Road

GLWA is aware of the traffic congestion on 13 Mile Road and is working to complete this portion of the project as quickly as possible while ensuring safety and quality.

Both GLWA and the City of Novi have been in contact with the Road Commission for Oakland County about adjusting the light timing at the intersection of 13 Mile and M-5. While RCOC is currently unwilling to adjust the light timing due to the potential impact it could have on M-5, the City of Novi is working with GLWA to come up with more solutions to alleviate traffic in the area.

Flaggers are now at the Walled Lake Early Childhood Center to help traffic flow during peak times. Next week, GLWA will pave the south eastbound lane in preparation to shift traffic.

13 Mile Road will remain open to eastbound traffic only through mid-October.

Meadowbrook Road (12 Mile to 13 Mile)

Pipe installation is anticipated to be complete on Meadowbrook Road from 12 to 13 Mile in late 2023, which extends the closure of Meadowbrook from 12 to 13 Mile Road until the spring of 2024.

Taft Road Rehabilitation

Taft Road has reopened to two-way traffic. The roadway still has a final two-inch lift of asphalt to be placed, which is anticipated to take place in late September at night in order to avoid a bulk of the Novi and Northville Schools traffic. The final lift or wearing course of asphalt will be placed under flag control.

Neighborhood Road Program: Concrete Streets

The contractor completed pouring back the patches and panels on Bertram Drive last week and should be able to fully reopen this week. Removals are complete on the second side of Heathergreene Court, and are moving over to begin removals on the east side of Highlands Drive, starting from Park Ridge Drive.

Important Information

Project schedules are only estimates. Work could be delayed for a number of factors, such as inclement weather.

Motorists should expect delays while work is in progress.

Driveway access may be impacted for residents located within the work zone
