



SUBJECT: Adoption of Resolution for application to the Transportation Alternatives

Program (TAP) grant for construction of a pathway connector between the

ITC Trail and Bosco Fields park.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The City of Novi is applying for a Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) grant for construction of a pathway connection between the existing ITC Trail and Bosco Fields park, which is located at 47481 11 Mile Road. The TAP is a federally funded program administered through the Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT). MDOT requires adoption of this resolution as part of the grant application process to indicate the expected level of financial support, authorize a specific agent to sign a project contract upon receipt of grant funding, commit to operation and maintenance of the pathway, and commit to responsibility of costs not covered by the grant. The tentative funding decision date is March 6, 2024.

The City Attorney has reviewed the resolution and sees no legal impediment (Beth Saarela, November 13, 2023).

WHEREAS; the City of Novi has authorized the Mayor and City Clerk, as representative on behalf of the City of Novi to sign a contract upon receipt of a grant funding award; and


WHEREAS: The City Engineer, or his or her designee, will act as agent/representative on behalf of the applicant agency during project development; and

WHEREAS; the City of Novi has committed to owning and maintaining the pathway connection between the ITC Trail and Bosco Fields park in perpetuity; and

WHEREAS; the City of Novi has claimed responsibility for engineering, permits, administration, potential cost overruns, and any non-participating costs.

application to MDOT in connection with the ITC Trail to Bosco Fields Pathway Connector, as outlined in the application.
