effect at the County and State level as it relates to the election of Precinct Delegates in
even-year elections and reporting in Presidential Primary Elections; and

Secretary of State by April 4, 2022; and
WHEREAS, the Election Commission submitted a written request to the Secretary of

WHEREAS, all precinct boundary changes must be approved by the local Election Commission and by the City Council; and
