Achievements Throughout the Year

- **Launched** Raising a Reader-1,000 Books Before Kindergarten. This early literacy campaign is in partnership with the Novi Community School District, Vibe Credit Union, the Friends of the Novi Library and Novi Rotary. The goal was 250 readers the first year and the Library exceeded the goal by registering 427 new readers (August 2016).
- **<u>Offered</u>** a device that allows patrons to transfer audio from vinyl records and cassette tapes to a digital format (October 2016).
- <u>Purchased</u> mobile hotspots for patrons to check out. Patrons have unlimited data with up to 10 Wi-Fi enabled devices (November 2016).
- <u>Hosted</u> the 7th Annual Community Reads with neighborhood libraries (Lyon Township, Northville District Library, Salem-South Lyon District Library, Wixom Public Library and Walled Lake City Library). The communities read the book <u>Born to Run</u> by Chris McDougall. Over 1,000 readers participated (November 2016).
- <u>Offered</u> one lucky couple the chance to win a wedding of a lifetime. Donations from local businesses made the wedding ceremony and reception possible (December 2016).
- **Donated** over 1,700 books to the SAY Detroit Play Center's new Lending Library (January 2017).

Did you know? The Library has a 3D printer that turns your ideas and digital designs into real objects, like toys, jewelry and mugs.

- **Added** 36 STEAM Kits (science, technology, engineering, art and math) to the Library for the community to check out (March 2017).
- <u>**Created**</u> a quarterly "Let's Read" cable taping with Superintendent of Novi Schools, Dr. Steve Matthews and Library Director, Julie Farkas, where they sit down and discuss great reads (April 2017).
- **Entered** and won the Collaborative Summer Library Program (CSLP) 2017 Teen Video Challenge at the state level (May 2017).
- **Launched** a new and updated website (novilibrary.org) designed to make it easier to navigate and search the Library's programs, databases and resources (June 2017).


