CITY MANAGER APPROVAL

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The City's Ordinance Review Committee (ORC) met on August 24, 2015 to discuss possible changes to the City's ordinances as they relate to access and activity in, primarily, municipal owned cemeteries. The amendment to the ordinance established specific rules of conduct applicable within cemeteries both public and private. These rules supplement other ordinance provisions generally governing conduct in public, but are specifically related to the sorts of activities that can occur in a cemetery. The intention of the amendment is to assist in the enforcement of such rules in appropriate cases. Recently, the City has experienced some undesirable activities in one of the two municipal owned cemeteries. With a focus on preservation of headstones, artifacts, and plaques, it was decided to bring forth a recommendation to the ORC to develop regulations that would, ultimately, assist with enforcement and prosecution. Moving forward, access to cemeteries will be prohibited after 9 p.m. or dusk, whichever is earlier, and 6:00 a.m. The ORC unanimously recommended these new provisions for consideration from the City Council of the whole. The first reading was approved by City Council on September 14, 2015.

ORDINANCE NO. 15-185

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CITY OF NOVI CODE OF ORDINANCES, AT CHAPTER 22, "OFFENSES," ARTICLE V, "OFFENSES AGAINST PUBLIC PEACE," TO ADD A NEW SECTION 22-102, "CONDUCT IN CEMETERIES," IN ORDER TO ESTABLISH RULES FOR APPROPRIATE CONDUCT IN CEMETERIES WITHIN THE CITY.

THE CITY OF NOVI ORDAINS:

Part I. That Chapter 22, "Offenses," Article V, "Offenses Against Public Peace," of the City of Novi Code of Ordinances shall be amended to add a new Section 22-102, "Conduct in Cemeteries," to read as follows:

Sec. 22-102 Conduct in Cemeteries

- (a) It shall be unlawful for any person to:
 - (1) Drive, operate, or cause to be driven or operated, any vehicle in or on any cemetery grounds, except in those limited and clearly marked areas specifically designed for the operation of a vehicle.
 - (2) Damage, disturb, deface, soil, molest, grave dig, remove, move, knock down, or knock over any burial space, tombstone, burial marker, earth, land, tree, shrub, flowers, artifacts, objects, or other personal or real property in a cemetery.
 - (3) Disobey or disregard any posted rule, sign, or direction in a cemetery.
 - (4) Disobey or disregard any rule or direction given by an owners, agent, or employee of a cemetery.
 - (5) Refuse to immediately leave the premises of a cemetery when directed to by an owner, agent, or employee of a cemetery.
 - (6) Enter, be on the premises, or remain on the premises of a cemetery between the hours of 9:00 PM (or dusk, whichever is earlier) and 06:00 AM, Sunday to Saturday, unless cemetery rules specifically allow otherwise.
 - (7) Refuse to immediately obey any direction, order or instructions of any police officer (includes all law enforcement officers, peace officers, deputy sheriffs, troopers, or code enforcement officials), while on the premises of a cemetery.

(b) Exception

An owner, agent, or employee of a cemetery may give explicit written permission for a person or persons to act outside of the prohibitions listed in sections (a)(1)-(6). Such written permission shall exempt enforcement shall exempt enforcement of sections (a)(1)-(6), limited to the permission(s) listed on the written permission. The written permission shall be on letterhead from the cemetery, dated an signed by an owner, agent, or employee of the cemetery, and shall include the printed or typed name of the owner, agent, or employee giving the permission, as well as including daytime and after hours contact phone numbers and an address where that owner, agent, or employee may be reached both during daytime and after hours. In order to avail themselves of the exemption(s) contained in the written permission, any person claiming said exemption shall carry the written permission with them at all times while on cemetery property, and shall present the original written permission to a police officer upon being stopped or contacted by a police officer, or upon the request of a police officer. Failure to carry or present to a police officer the written permission shall invalidate any written permission, exemption and/or defense to enforcement of (a)(1)-(6). permission shall be effective for no more than 90 days from its dated issuance.

(c) Penalty

Violation of this section is a misdemeanor.

PART II. Severability. Should any section, subdivision, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance be declared by the courts to be invalid, the validity of the Ordinance as a whole, or in part, shall not be affected other than the part invalidated.

PART III. <u>Savings Clause</u>. The amendment of the Novi Code of Ordinances set forth in this Ordinance does not affect or impair any act done, offense committed, or right accruing, accrued, or acquired or liability, penalty, forfeiture or punishment, pending or incurred prior to the amendment of the Novi Code of Ordinances set forth in this Ordinance.

PART IV. Repealer. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

PART V. <u>Effective Date</u>. The provisions of this Ordinance are ordered to take effect following publication in the manner prescribed by the Charter of the City of Novi.
