If possible no cars parked in the street. The sole purpose of our WMHA is to preserve and enhance the value of our property, improve the environment and quality of our neighborhood.

BE A RESPONSIBLE NEIGHBOR

Dog owners pick up! Respect our neighborhood, don't put dog poop bags in the Commons receptacle! Dogs and Cats *must be leashed,* City Ordinance. Cats love to roam, dig in your landscaping, water your parked car wheels and instinctively hunt! ALL TRASH CANS MUST BE stored inside your garage or at the back of your home OUT OF SIGHT!! If your trash cans are not stored properly you are in violation of our CCR's and will be dealt with accordingly. Any noise, suspicious activity, loitering, vandalism, disrespect etc. will not be tolerated! WMHA and our partnership with the Novi Police Department remains. Call NPD immediately if you witness *anything* suspicious or uncomfortable!

COVENANT CORNER

Many of us bought our homes years ago however, we have many new neighbors since then. At the time of our purchase we agreed to abide by the Declaration of Covenants, Conditions and Restrictions (a.k.a. CCR's) A printable link can be found on our City Website. It is recommended that if you do not posses a copy you should print one for your edification and file. The Architectural Control Committee reviews and makes decision on all requests from homeowners to make changes to their properties. The ACC tries to assure that all changes to properties conforms to appropriate guidelines. Approval from the ACC must be obtained prior to the start of almost every external modification, improvement or addition.

2018 NEIGHBORHOOD ENTRYWAY ENHANCEMENT MATCHING GRANT

The Neighborhood Matching Grant Program established by the Novi City Council provides funding assistance to Novi's Homeowner Associations. The matching funds support the efforts to enhance neighborhoods through high-quality entranceway beautification projects. Many of these approved programs can be seen close by, Turtle Creek, Meadowbrook Lake, Charrington Green to name a few. Whispering Meadows has completed all criteria for the program and presented our application to the Review Committee and completed the mandatory financial, structural, estimates and photographic requirements. All designated information has been submitted for review and approval by the designated deadline. Neighborhood/Associations are eligible for a 50% matching award up to \$5,000 at the City's sole discretion. We have been notified that all requirements have been met and all materials received by City Committee. The City requires a completed application, current budget, documentation reflecting Association current and previous spending on landscaping and maintenance, well defined and scaled plans of the proposed project and a map with project location identified plus photography of present existing entryway sign. The completed application and all attachments have been submitted to the City Manager's office. We remain anxious and look forward to approval so that we may begin the project this Spring. We are confident you will be pleased and proud of the new WM Entranceway Sign when complete.

SANDPOINT LAKE PARTNERSHIP RENEWED

Whispering Meadows is fortunate to share a very beautiful and pristine lake with our long time partner Cross Winds West. This year we are happy to announce that a new partner, the Heights of Novi apartments has joined us. We have invited and encouraged their participation over the years and at last they have. The three partners share in keeping our Lake clean and free of algae. It is also tested for water purity. This cost sharing enables the partners including WM to keep 6 aerators operating 24/7, algae spraying and removal plus water testing. Our frontage is to the South and West of the Lake however, with the co-op venture we have access to the entire Lake. Our very diverse population of wildlife including water fowl, Ducks, Geese, Heron, Egret all visit our lake. That also includes our Deer, Coyote, Fox, Raccoon, Opossum, Muskrat, Hawks and yes, the Novi Eagles. It also supports, Turtles, frogs and rumor has it very good sized Fish. We have a large Private Property sign posted at the West end of Sandpoint Lake....a bench to sit and enjoy the view!
