### **BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

The Meadowbrook Commons Facility is a development designed for elderly residents comprised of one three story mid-rise building and nine single story buildings. It has 175 units, 85 one-bedroom and 30 two-bedroom units in the mid-rise building and 60 two-bedroom ranch style units in the single story buildings. Attached to Meadowbrook Commons is the Meadowbrook Activity Center.

This project will replace the 14 year old common area carpeting in the entire third floor hallway, third floor waiting area, theater room and the massage room. The new carpet will assist in maintaining the high standard of keeping Meadowbrook Commons pristine for current residents and to attract new residents.

In accordance with the City's purchasing policy, an Invitation for Bids (ITB) was posted on the Michigan Intergovernmental Trade Network (MITN) website (149 firms received email notice of the ITB). Falcon Carpet was the only firm that submitted a bid. The bid is outside the established budget parameters for the project. Funds from the Senior Housing Fund will be utilized for payment.

### **SPECIFICATIONS**

### A. Background:

The City of Novi is soliciting a contractor to replace carpeting at Meadowbrook Commons, an older adult residential living community. Carpeting will be replaced in the hall ways, sitting areas, massage room and craft room on the third floor.

### B. Scope of the Work:

The Scope of work includes furnish, deliver, remove existing carpet and base, all floor preparation and installation of new carpet tile and contractor supplied cove base.

The successful bid contractor shall furnish: all tools, equipment, labor, materials, transportation and trained personnel to accomplish the specifications of this contract.

**Actual dimensions are the contractor's responsibility.** Measurements must be taken during the mandatory site visit to verify dimensions prior to bidding or ordering or manufacturing any items covered in the specifications. There will be no other opportunity provided for contractor to take measurements.

The contractor will provide one (1) person on site as the project manager. This project manager will handle all issues and complete the final walk thru for all items necessary for repair.

### Preparation

- 1. The contractor shall remove all existing carpet and cove base from hallways, sitting areas, massage room, and craft room and properly dispose of material. The contractor must provide its own means of disposal.
- 2. The contractor shall clean floors and walls as required by the carpet manufacturer's specifications for pre-installation.
- 3. The contractor shall move all case good furniture, so as to demo existing carpet tiles and wall base.
- 4. All personal items on top of case goods will be boxed and moved prior to work commencement.

### Installation

- Carpet tile shall be installed in strict accordance with manufacturer's written instructions and recommendations; maintain uniformity of direction and lay of pile.
- 2. The carpet tile shall cover from wall to wall.
- 3. The carpet tile shall be laid directly on the floor and made to adhere to the floor with an adhesive that is impervious to water and carpet cleaning solutions. Apply floor adhesive uniformly to substrate in accordance with manufacturer's instructions.

- 4. Remove adhesive promptly from face of carpet.
- 5. Carpeting tiles that terminate at doorways, work areas or walk-off areas leading to hallways shall be trimmed evenly and edge secured in vinyl stripping. Strips shall be adhered to the floor with industrial strength adhesive.
- 6. Apply cove base at all adhered carpet installations to walls or other permanent fixtures in rooms or areas where base is required.
  - a. Install base in lengths as long as practical.
  - b. Tightly bond base to backing throughout the length of each piece, with continuous contact at horizontal and vertical surfaces.
  - c. On masonry surfaces or other similar irregular surfaces, fill voids along top edge of wall base with base manufacturer's recommended adhesive filler material.

### Cleaning

- 1. Upon completion of the installation, remove all waste materials, tools and equipment.
- 2. Using commercial vacuums, thoroughly vacuum the entire floor surfaces to the Owner's satisfaction.
- 3. Remove spots or replace carpet where spots cannot be removed.

- A. Source limitations: Products of the manufacturer shall be provided through a single source
- B. Only manufacturer's recommended leveling and patching compounds shall be used
- C. All adhesive shall be water resistant, mildew resistant, non-staining. Pressure sensitive to suit products and subfloor conditions and must comply with flammability requirements for carpet installed tile and is provided by the carpet manufacturer and recommended by carpet tile manufacturer for releasable installation

### Warranty

The Contractor shall provide the City a copy of the 10-year wear/color fastness warranty supplied by the carpet manufacturer. Contractor shall guarantee all workmanship for a period of five (5) years after final acceptance.

Representatives of the City of Novi shall perform inspection during and upon completion of the work. The Contractor shall correct any discrepancies noted during the final inspection.

### Method of work

- 1. All work shall be performed in the best and most professional manner.
- 2. Throughout the entire project, the Contractor shall maintain the work site in a safe, neat, and orderly manner.
- 3. The Contractor shall adhere to OSHA-MISHA regulations throughout the project to insure the safety of his/her employees, state employees, and the public.
- 4. The Contractor shall take steps to prevent the accumulation of debris at the job site.

### **General Requirements**

- 1. All work shall be coordinated with the Facility Operations Manager.
- 2. Work shall be accomplished outside of the normal work hours of 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, unless permission is giving in writing by the Facility Operations Manager to do otherwise.
- 3. Appropriate, non-offensive clothing is to be worn by any and all contractors, subcontractors, and their representatives.
- 4. All Contractors must sign in/out, and wear a badge supplied by the City
